

During an investigation of Unknowns associated with decedents from the USS Mansten that were in Manuii, it was discovered that Unknown X-6 was also associated with decedents from the USS Mousten, and this Office directed that X-6 be shipped to Manuii for simultaneous reprocessing with the remains in Manuii for pessible identification. Movever, identification was not effected and Unknown X-6 was left as Unidentifiable, along with the other remains that were originally associated with the USS Mouston.
