
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

Picture a man, average in height, weighing 150 to 155 lbs. The shoulders were narrow and he was of average muscularity. The skull is average in size and a narrow oval in outline. The backhead projects slightly and has an external occipital protuberance that was probably palpable. The vault is relatively high and there is an uneven saggital crest. The forehead is high, narrow and sloping. In profile the face was straight and the nose convex. The face is narrow and rather long. The lower jaw is rather shallow. Although most of the nose region is missing it would appear that the nasal bridge was high and thin.

Parts listed under item # 20 have been made into C.I.L. # 587.


