U. S. Marine Corps casualty records and Dept. of the Navy medical records report that Pvt. Walter John LAZAROE, 369 817, USMC was killed in action on 27 September 1942 on Guadalcanal, BSI. Due to battle conditions the remains were not recovered.

Field Board Proceedings dated 11 February 1949 which recommended that the remains of Pvt. Lazaroe be declared non-recoverable were approved by the Navy Department and this Branch on 23 August 1949 after thorough screening of the records of the unknown remains recovered from Guadalcanal failed to reveal a favorable association with the physical and dental characteristics of Pvt. Lazaroe.

Correspondence from the sister of the deceased, Mrs. Rita L. Carter indicated she was of the belief that her brother's grave was in the ANM Cemetery, Guadalcanal. This information had been relayed to her by correspondence from a cousin, Mr. William M. Lazaroe Jr., who had visited a grave on Guadalcanal in 1944 which he believed was that of his cousin, the decedent.

A letter was forwarded Mr. William M. Lazaroe Jr., requesting the grave location and inquiring as to what knowledge he had of the case. His reply stated that he wasn't sure this was the grave of his cousin since the last name was spelled Lazro. He also returned a sketch of the cemetery with the position marked where he had seen the grave.

The cemetery plot map of Guadalcanal was checked for a grave by the name of Lazro or any similar spelling or name with negative results.

Rescreening of the records of Unknown remains recovered from Guadalcanal with the record of Pvt. Lazaroe resulted in only one (1) possible association, Unknown remains X-104, ANM Cemetery, Guadalcanal. The records report that X-104 was recovered from the same approximate location that Pvt. Lazaroe was killed and the physical characteristics compared favorably however further investigation revealed the following irreconcilable discrepancies:

- a. Dental. (See Attached Dental Comparison Chart).
- b. Fractured Collar Bone. (See ltr fr Mrs. Carter dtd 28 June 1952).

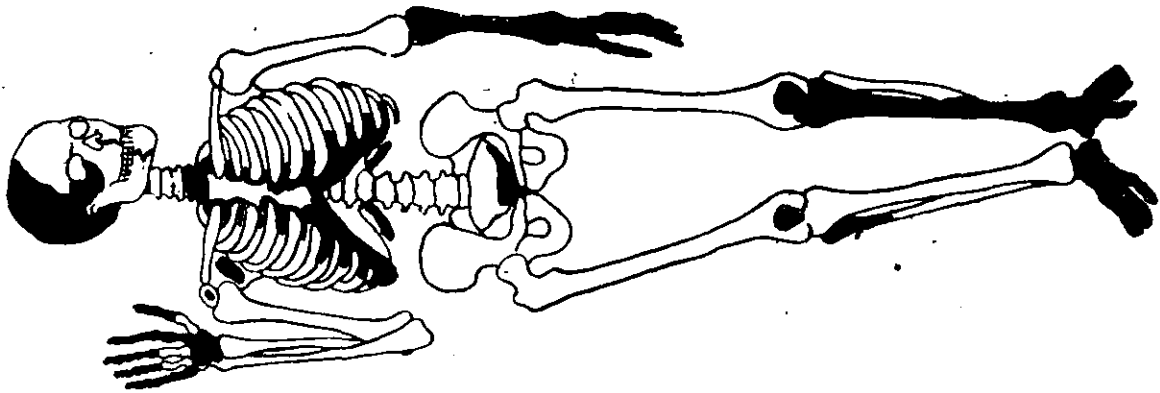

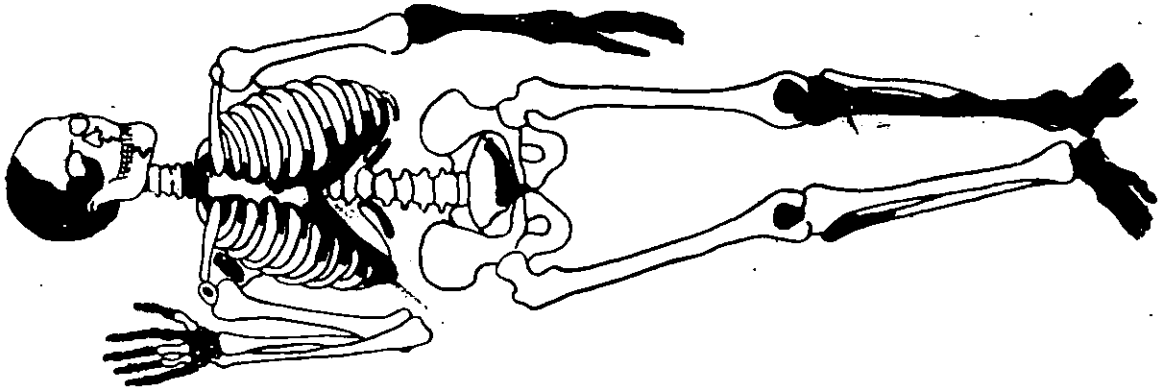
