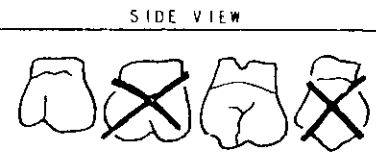

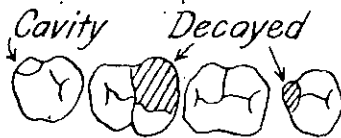

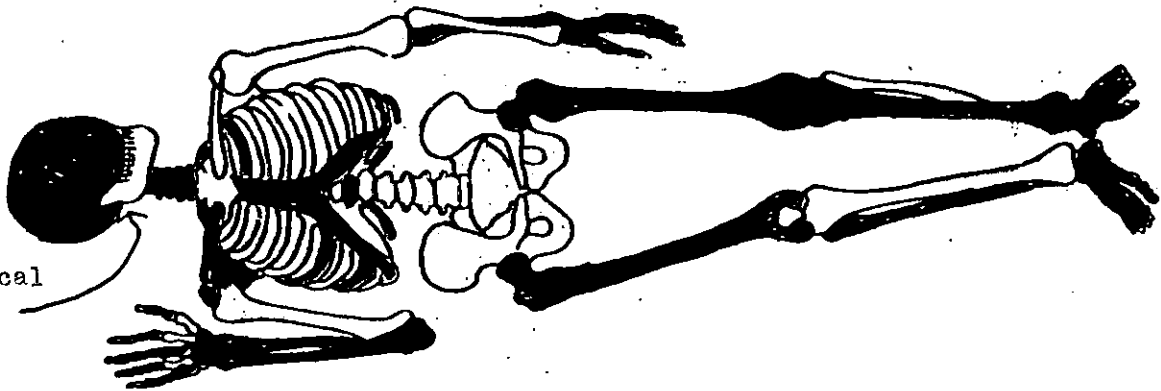

Unknown X-112, formerly of Guadalcanal,
Plot-C, Row-100, Grave-1.

Upon processing the remains of Unknown X-112, it was found to be remains involving two (2) young men. The cases were segregated and marked X-112 and X-112 "A". There were two (2) shoes, sizes $9\frac{1}{2}$ EE and 10 EE, inclosed were bones of two (2) complete feet. The foot bones from shoe $9\frac{1}{2}$ EE was associated with X-112 "A". The foot bones from shoe 10 EE could not be associated with either X-112 or X-112 A; therefore, they have been removed and classified as C.I.L. X-625.

The remains of Unknown X-108, Guadalcanal was compared with X-112 and X-112 A, no associations could be made and Unknown X-108 was replaced in the casket. X-108 had been previously processed completely.



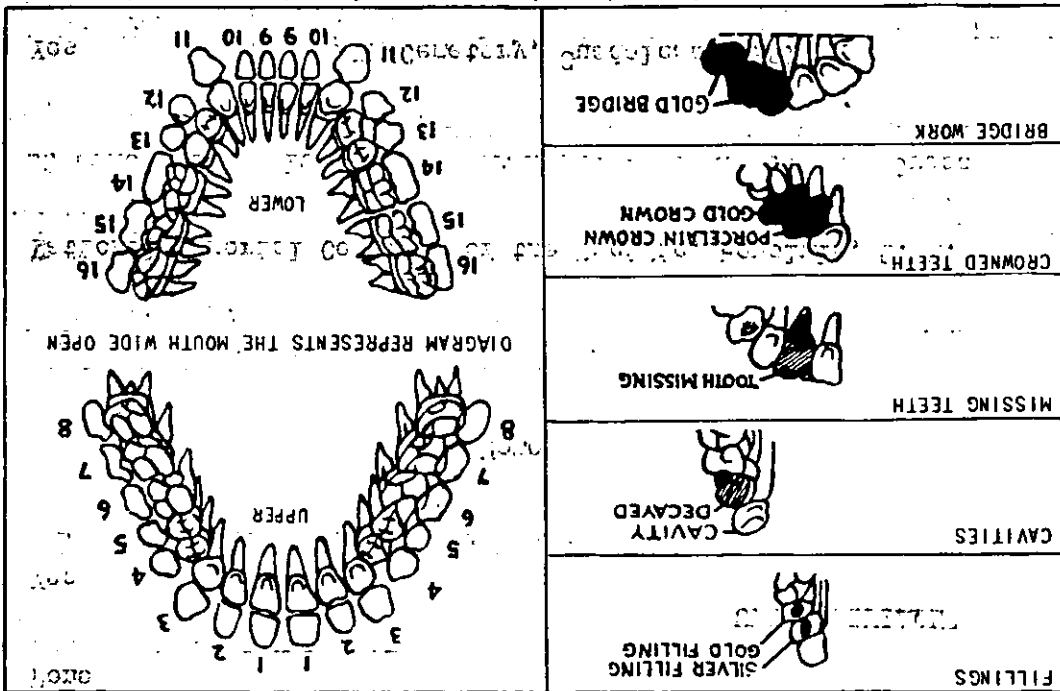


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN

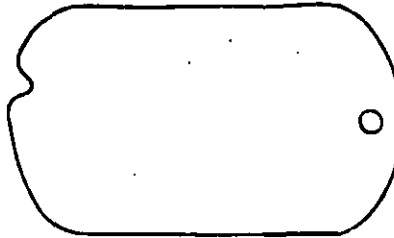







