





a. Private Pirst Glass Helson died of shock and hemogrhage on 28 December 1942, and his remains were recovered from the field and reported as re-buried 3 March 1943 in Plot A, Row 33, Grave 6, Army-Hevy-Harine Cemetery, Guadalesmal, Salessen Islands.

b. The remains of Unknown X-55 were buried 17 February 1943 in Plot A, Now 13, Grave 4, Army-Navy-Marine Constary, Quadaleanal, Solemon Islands.

- c. In March 1948 the remains from Plot A, Row 33, Grave 6, Army-Mavy-Marine Cemetery, Quedaleanal were emmined at the Central Identification Laboratory, and Ferm 1044 was accomplished and compared with the original dental chart of Private First Class Nelson obtained from The Quartermaster General with unfavorable results.
- d. In February 1948 the remains of Unknown X-55, Flot A, Row 13, Grave 4, Army-Havy-Harine Genetery, Guadaloanal, were examined at the Central Identification Laboratory, and Form 1044 was accomplished and ecompared with the original deutal chart of Private First Class Helson obtained from The Quarternaster demoral with very favorable results.
- e. One (1) eriginal Identification tag reading: Paul I. Helson, 36030507, T-42, Eince Helson, Easty, North Dabota, O P, was also found with the remains from Plot A, Row 13, Grave 4, Army-Havy-Harine Comstery, Guadalcanal, Solemon Islands.

3. Gamelusions -

- a. That Private First Class Helson died of shock and hemorrhage and the remains erroneously marked after burial.
- b. That the remains now designated as Unknown X-55 are those of Private First Class Helson by comparison of dental record from The Quartermaster General and finding of one (1) original Identification tag reading: Paul Y. Helson, 36030507, T-42, Einse Helson, Easty, Horth Dakota, O P, with the remains of Unknown X-55.
- e. That the remains now designated as Private First Class Welson could never have been identified by comparison of dental charts.

4. Recommendations

- a. That the remains now designated as Unknown X-55, Plot A, Row 13, Grave 4, Army-Havy-Marine Cometory, Quadalonnal, be declared to be positively identified as Private First Class Paul Y. Helson, 36030507, USA.
- b. That the remains now designated as Private First Class Nelson be declared an erreneous identification and re-designated as Unknown I-55, Plot A, New 33, Grave 6, Army-Mavy-Marine Cemetery, Quadalcanal, Selemon Islands.


