1. Transmitted herewith QMC Form 1044 for thirty-seven (37) unidentified remains, stamped and signed in accordance with letter, DA OQMG QMGMU 293 GPS (Pacific Zone), Subj: Resolution of Cases of Unidentified Deceased dated 22 September 1948.
2. The majority of these unknowns have no dental anatomy or clues that might lead to identification, other than location and in some instances, date of death. All such clues have been investigated, with negative results.
3. The remainder that have dental anatomy could possibly compare with many persons missing, thereby precluding any individual identification.

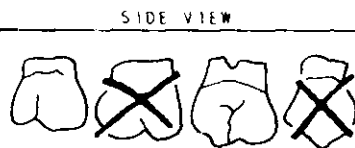

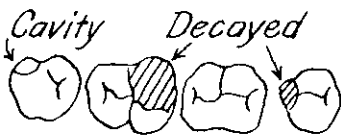

21. REMARKS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Picture a fairly tall, well-muscled older man with an average type of body build. The skull appears to be of average size and has an oval outline. The backhead has a small amount of projection and the external occipital protuberance was probably palpable.

The face appears to have been rectangular in shape with the usual fullness. The glabella region was very large. The nose appears to have been very prominent and straight in profile. The mouth parts probably projected noticeably. The upper lip was probably short. The lower jaw presents a prominent rounded chin eminence of average width.

Fluoroscopic examination negative. Teeth charted.
