



21. REMARKS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Ficture an average-sized young man 19-20 years of age with wavy auburn hair and an average body build. The shull is of small average in size and a long oval shape. The backhead has a small protuberance. The face is long and narrow with flat sides. The forehead is rather narrow and the browridges are small. The lower face is as wide as the upper. All the facial features are rather gracile. In profile the nose forms a narrow, high, convex bridge, which is twisted towards the left side. The mouth parts are slightly projective. The chin appears rather deep, and the line of the jaw long. The cheek bones lie flat against the skull. The palate is quite high and rather narrow.

The greater torsian of the tibial shaft suggests this individual may have walked toeing out.
