


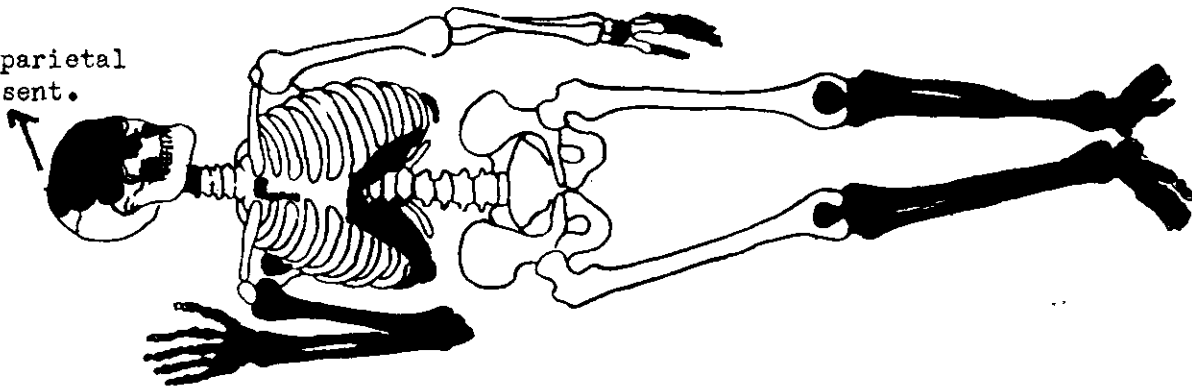

Complete description cannot be given because much of the skull is missing. The palate is high. The mandible is rather narrow but heavy in structure. The chin is bilateral and lacks any gonial flare.

Fluoroscopical examination unnecessary. Teeth charted.


