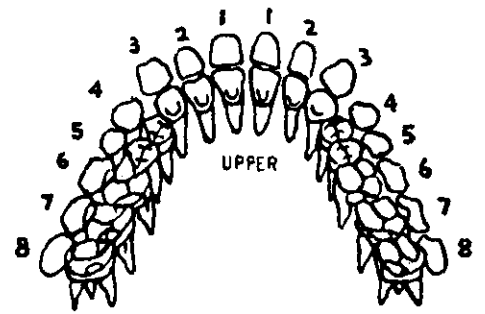
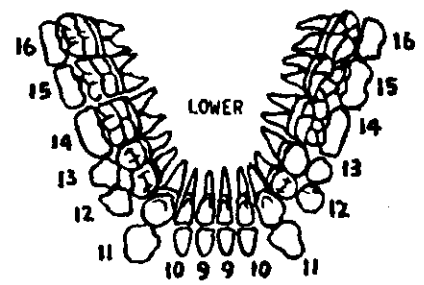
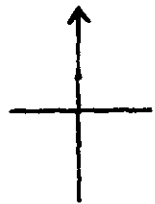


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN
