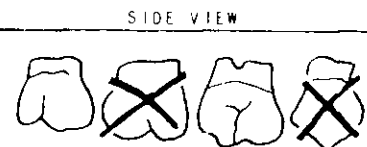

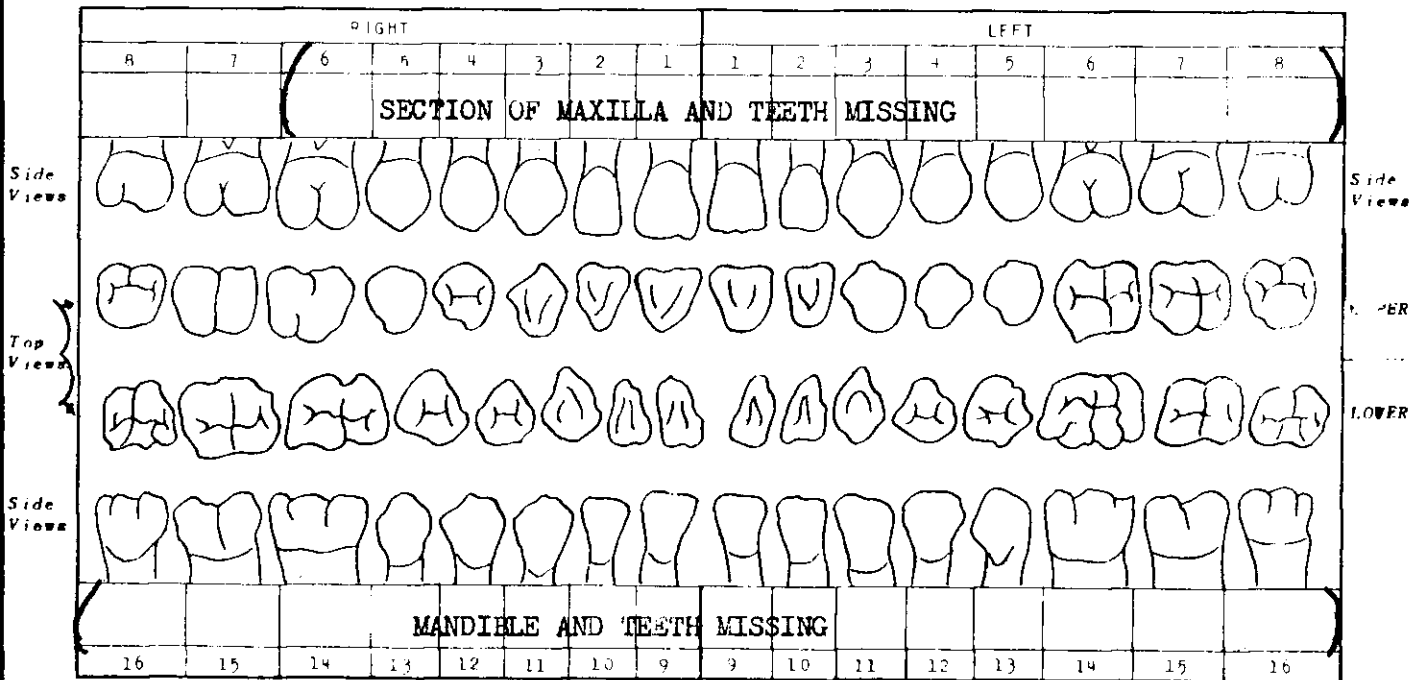
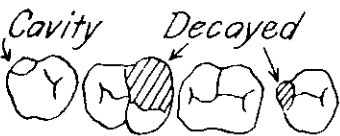

The remains of 83 "A" and 83 "B" were rewrapped separately and returned to the temporary casket.


