

"a. That due to the lack of distinguishing characteristics, individual identification cannot be established beyond a reasonable doubt.

"b. That the remains of Unknowns X-37, X-38, and X-39 are confirmed as an Unknown Group Burial."

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

1. Submitted herewith the case of Unknowns X-37, X-38 and X-39 formerly interred in Plot FMC Row 71 Grave 7, Army Navy Marine Cemetery, Guadalcanal for review and action in accordance with letter, WT AGO-S, 293.9 (27 Mar 47) D-M dated 9 April 1947.

2. Summary

a. All that is known of Unknowns X-37, X-38 and X-39 is that they were buried in a common grave on 8 December 1942, and at that time the flesh was decomposed and no identifying marks were found.

b. In an attempt to identify these remains every marine unaccounted for on Guadalcanal prior to 8 December 1942, (a total of 314), was considered, and comparisons of dental and physical characteristics made between Forms 371 and 1044. The results were entirely negative.

The reasons for limiting the search to marines was that prior to December 1942 no army personnel were operating on Guadalcanal, and the fact that the grave contained a marine corps shoe. The fact that the remains were decomposed by December 1942 indicates that death took place sometime prior.

3. Conclusions

a. That in all probability the remains are those of Marine Corps personnel.

b. That every reasonable and practicable effort to identify these remains has been made, to no avail, inasmuch as every marine missing on Guadalcanal prior to 8 Dec 1942 has been considered and compared, and none can be identified with these unknowns.

c. That to further delay the final disposition will serve no useful purpose. Since the remains are now segregated, and will be interred in separate graves, no confusion will result in case future developments point to individual identity, as the necessary record changes can be made without disturbing the grave or graves.

4. Recommendations

a. That the remains of Unknowns X-37, X-38 and X-39 be declared to constitute an Unknown Group Burial.

b. That segregation be maintained and the remains buried in accordance with forthcoming Disinterment Directives.
