

Sir:

A wedding ring was found in the ruins of a burned jeep in France during June 1944 and forwarded to this office.

The name engraved thereon appeared to be "A.G. Wolke, 32". As this name could not be identified as a member of the Armed Forces of the United States, the ring was forwarded to the FBI for examination.

On the inside of the ring there appeared a jeweler's mark which revealed the numbers "685", raised inside a small rectangular indentation. The ring was said to be of foreign make, English or French, but more probably English.

Information is requested if such a name appears in the roster of your headquarters as a member of the Expeditionary Force, and if he was known to have been in action in France prior to 16 June 1944.

RESULTS OF EXAMINATIONS:

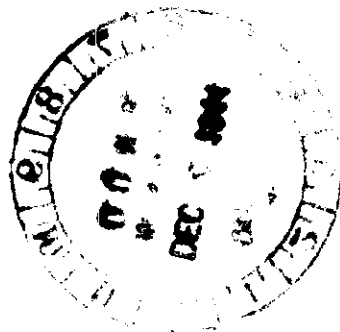
On the inside of the ring, Q9, to the left of the visible engraving "A. G. Weihn. 32" there appeared a jeweler's mark that was not legible without treatment. A subsequent restoration process was successful in revealing the numbers "585" to be present. These numbers appeared raised inside a small rectangular indentation.

From an examination of the unusual jeweler's mark, various sources of information stated that this ring was of foreign make, being English or French, but more probably English.

It is believed that the number "585" is meant to designate the fineness of the gold. The "fineness" is an alternate way of expressing the carat, 1000 fine being equivalent to 24 carats. This method of expressing the carats is not common on jewelry in this country. The fineness 585 would be equivalent to approximately 14 carats.

The evidence, designated as specimen Q9, will be returned under separate cover, appropriate photographic copies having been prepared.

1. Enclosed is a ring, evidently a wedding ring. This was found in the ruins of a burnt jeep. The vehicle was completely destroyed and the crew were cremated in it. Not enough was left to identify any of the victims or the organization to which the vehicle was assigned. The vehicle was in an ordnance salvage dump when the ring was found.

2. The wife of the victim would perhaps value the ring. I wish that your department would forward it to her.
