CASE HISTORY

UNKNOWN X-70054 UNKNOWN X-70055 Griesheim/Main (Med) Mausoleum

The remains now designated Unknown X-70054 and X-70055 were recovered from cultivated field, the property of a Judge Vincenzo Formica, located approximately six (6) kilometers southeast of ARDEA (F-837308), Italy. Remnants of US type equipment were found with the scattered portions of remains.

The remains X-70054 consist of the major portion of a skull; an almost complete mandible; shafts of the right and left humerus; a broken right femur, and a portion of the pelvis. More than half of the teeth are post-humously missing, and there are no fillings in teeth present. Unknown X-70055 consists of only the major portion of a skull.

A review of Mediterranean Zone files on casualties lost and of remains recovered in the general area of Ardea, Italy has failed to provide an association.

In view of the lack of identifying media, it is believed that Un-knowns X-70054 and X-70055 should be declared Unidentifiable.


