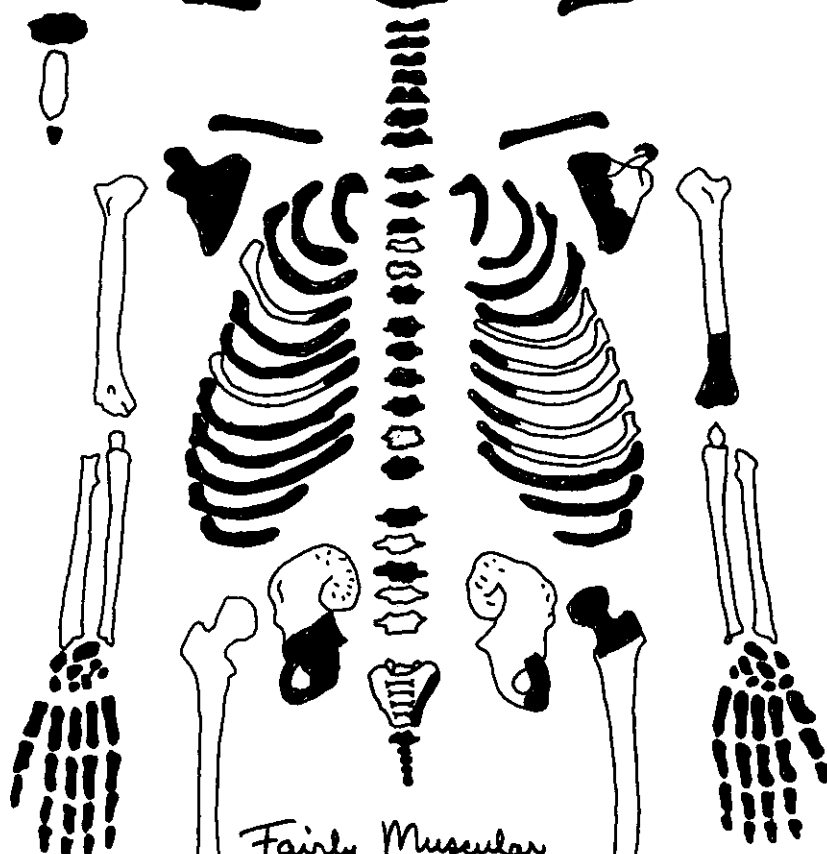

Examination of X-70068 associated with 2/LT JAMES C. YOUNG, O-762 860

These skeletal remains are reported to have been a separate recovery associated with a dog tag and also a "Mae West", both bearing the name and serial number of Lt. Young.

The purpose of this examination was to evaluate the field identification of the actual remains as those of Lt. Young and to determine whether they might properly be included in the group burial G.B.-295 JBNC at Jefferson Barracks National Cemetery.

My examination of the remains indicates an estimated stature of 5'9½" or slightly above, and a moderately well muscled individual whose body weight, when in condition, would fall between 150 and 170 lbs.

The three molar teeth recovered show no fillings nor do those on the records of Lt. Young. Evidence relating to age and race are insufficient, although the limb proportions suggest that the subject is almost certainly white.

SUMMARY: With the exception of the estimated stature, there is little positive information to be gleaned from these remains. Without the dog tag and Mae West the data for positive identification are insufficient. However, additional data, such as from the teeth, give no reason for not associating these remains with the ID tag and the marked Mae West. On these grounds the reasons for identifying these remains as those of Lt. Young are probable.

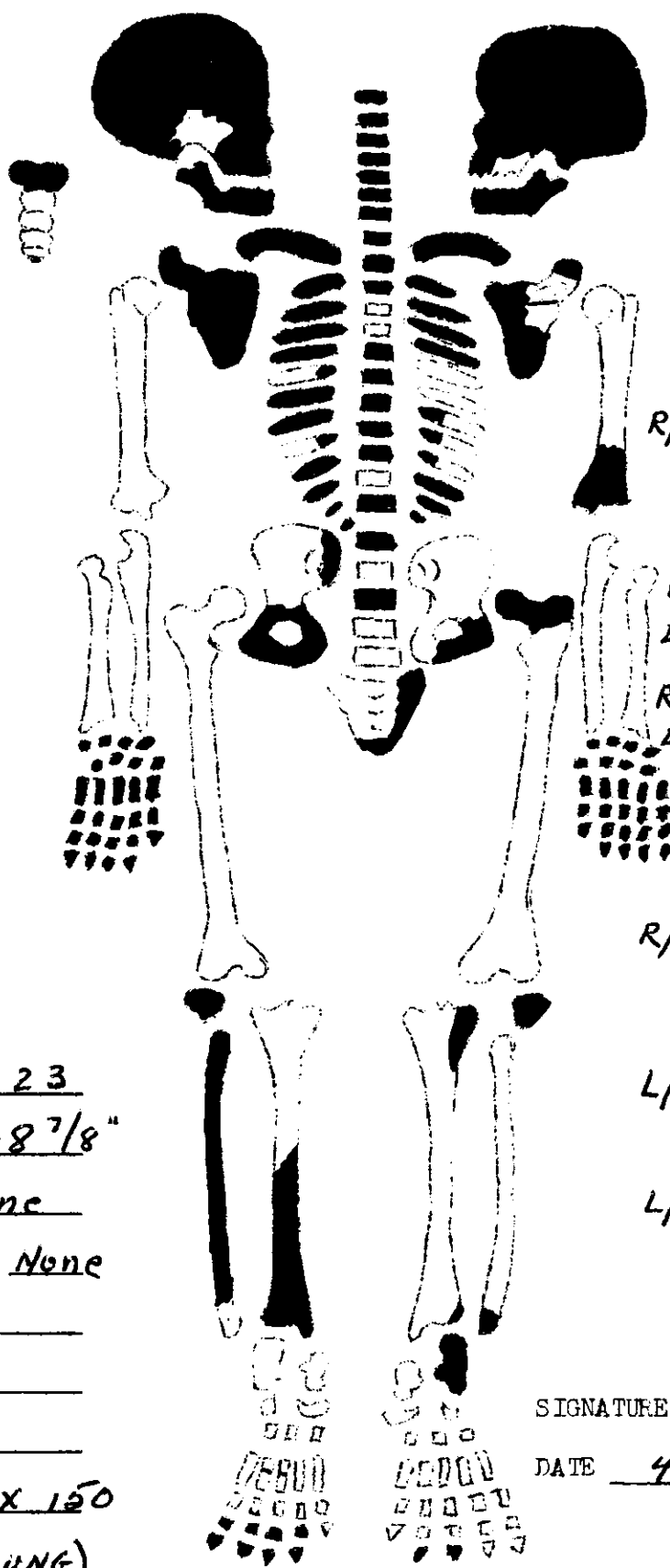

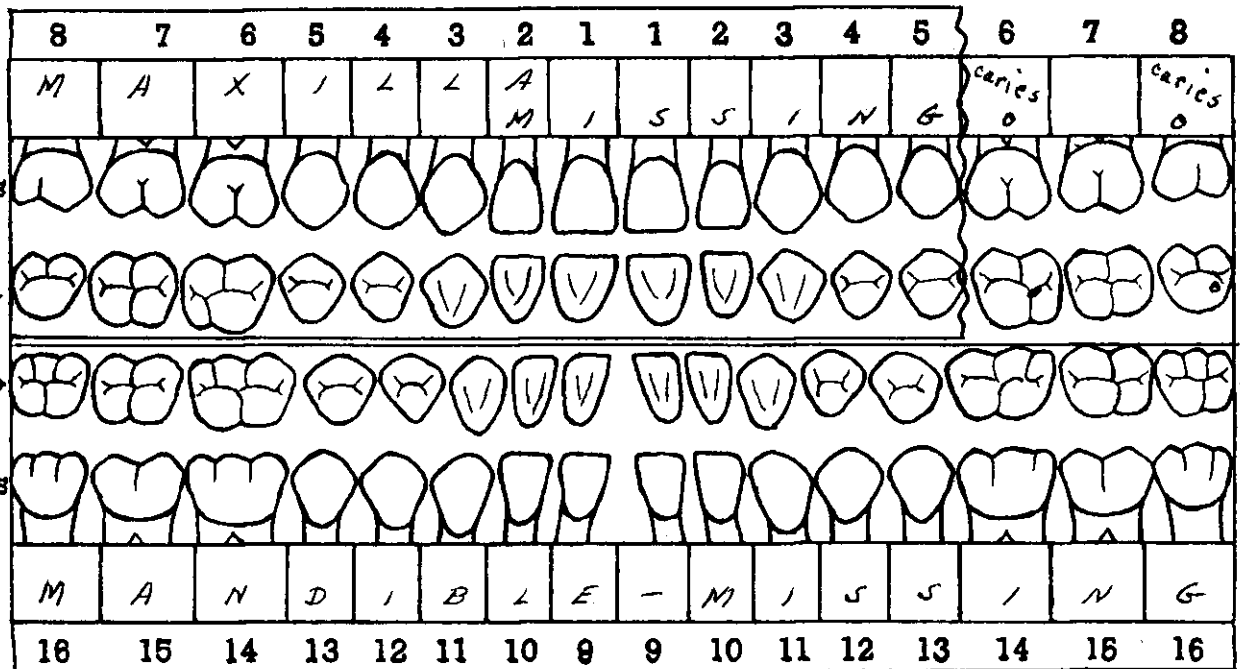

IDENTIFICATION LABORATORY REPORT

1. Search and Recovery Case # 778 pertains to the remains of one (1) US World War II deceased recently recovered from the mountain area of GUTENSTEIN (O-48/X-95), Austria. Found with this remains were remnants of US Air Force clothing and equipment, one (1) ID tag for "JAMES C YOUNG O-762860 T-43-44 B P" and a "Mae West" life preserver bearing the stencilled name and A.S.N. of "JAMES C YOUNG O-762860". Available records, this headquarters, indicate US A/C B-17 G # 42-30385 crashed 26 July 1944 in the vicinity of GUTENSTEIN, Austria with a loss of ten (10) crew members. 2/Lt James C. YOUNG, O-762860 was a crew member of subject A/C and the only recoverable remains are currently in a Group Burial consisting of Unknowns X-7497 thru X-7499 and X-7504.

2. Pending the approval of identification SR Case # 778 has been assigned an Unknown "X" number as follows:

3. The physical characteristics of subject deceased have been favorably compared with like data for 2/Lt James C. YOUNG, as outlined below:

The only teeth present are L 6, 7, 8 in the portion of maxilla. There are no fillings or caries present in these three teeth and they agree with the dental data for 2/Lt YOUNG which indicates all teeth were present and "O.K." The remains recovered indicate that portions for just one (1) deceased are present.

(Identification Laboratory Report X-70068, dated 4 January 1955, cont'd)

4. It is noted that the actual recovery of these portions was made by the local Gendarmerie. Apparently a considerable number of portions were overlooked by them and the presence of snow in the area prevented further recovery by investigators from this headquarters when they visited the area. The recovery of this one (1) additional deceased indicates that others may still be in the vicinity of recovery. It is recommended that an additional search be made in the area at a time when the snow has receded in an attempt to recover other crew members and the overlooked portions of the currently recovered deceased.

5. CAUSE OF DEATH: The shattered condition of subject remains indicates death was caused as a result of an air crash.

NARRATIVE OF INVESTIGATION

I. AUTHORITY AND MATTERS INVESTIGATED:

In compliance with Investigation Directive # 1194, this headquarters dated 4 December 1954, the undersigned proceeded to Gutenstein (O-48/X-95), Austria in an effort to recover the remains of a US World War II decedent reportedly discovered at above location.

II. FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES:

A letter received from the Quartermaster US Forces in Austria informed this headquarters that remains of one (1) or probably two (2) US World War II deceased have been found in the mountain area of Gutenstein.

III. FINDINGS:

On 4 December 1954, the undersigned proceeded to Salzburg, Austria where Grey Passes were obtained for travel to Vienna through the Russian Zone of Austria. Upon arrival at Vienna, Lt Col Jones, G-2 from Vienna Headquarters Command was contacted as directed. Grey Passes for Wiener-Neustadt and Gutenstein were received and arrangements were made by Col Jones for the undersigned to contact the Soviet Kommandantur at Wiener-Neustadt where more details concerning the discovery of the remains would be available.

At the Wiener-Neustadt Kommandantur, the undersigned were received by a Soviet Lt Col who stated that remains were found in November 1954 by a Gutenstein inhabitant. The Kommandantur authorities advised the local Gendarmerie to leave the remains and objects found at the place of discovery, and that the US authorities would be advised of the findings. The Kommandant assigned a Soviet 1st Lieut and an Austrian interpreter as guides, and were instructed to contact the Gutenstein Gendarmerie Post for recovery of remains.

In the company of the Soviet escort officer and his interpreter, the undersigned contacted the Gendarmerie Post of Gutenstein. There it was learned that the remains and personal effects were already gathered by the Gendarmerie and deposited at the local cemetery morgue. The identification tag was forwarded to the Gendarmerie headquarters of Wiener-Neustadt. The Soviet officer had the Gendarme call his headquarters and instruct them to deliver the identification tag to the Soviet Kommandantur.

(Narrative of Investigation, dated 15 December 1954, ID # 1194, cont'd)

With the assistance of two Gendarmes, the party first proceeded to the location where the remains were found.

At approximately  $4\frac{1}{2}$  kilometers west of Gutenstein, the party led by the Gendarmes arrived in the woods of Weissenbachgraben, district of Gutenstein. At a height of 800 meters, the spot where the remains were discovered was pointed out. A five inch blanket of snow covered the entire area. The area however, was searched but no additional portions of remains were found. There was no indication of a plane crash such as a crater or any evidence of the wreckage of the plane.

According to the Gendarmes, in summer 1944, two US aircraft collided, several members of the crews parachuted to safety, however, the Gendarmes stated that they did not know the location of the actual crashes. Attention is invited to exhibit "A" approximate location where remains were discovered.

The party then proceeded to the Gutenstein cemetery morgue where the undersigned took custody of a wooden box containing the remains. A "Mae West" and other pieces of US type clothing were found with remains. Returning to the Gendarmerie, the undersigned obtained a copy of the original report relating the circumstances surrounding the discovery of the remains. Attention is invited to exhibit "B" copy of the report.

Upon return to the Wiener-Neustadt Kommandantur, the commanding officer turned over the identification tag found with the remains. The identification tag was inscribed JAMES C YOUNG O-762860 T43-44 B P. The Soviet officers were thanked for their interest in the case; their aid to the undersigned in recovering the remains.

Prior to our return to Frankfurt, Lt Col Jones was contacted and advised the results of the investigation.

#### IV. CONCLUSIONS:

Remains were evacuated to the Griesheim Mausoleum, and assigned SR # 778.

#### V. RECOMMENDATIONS:

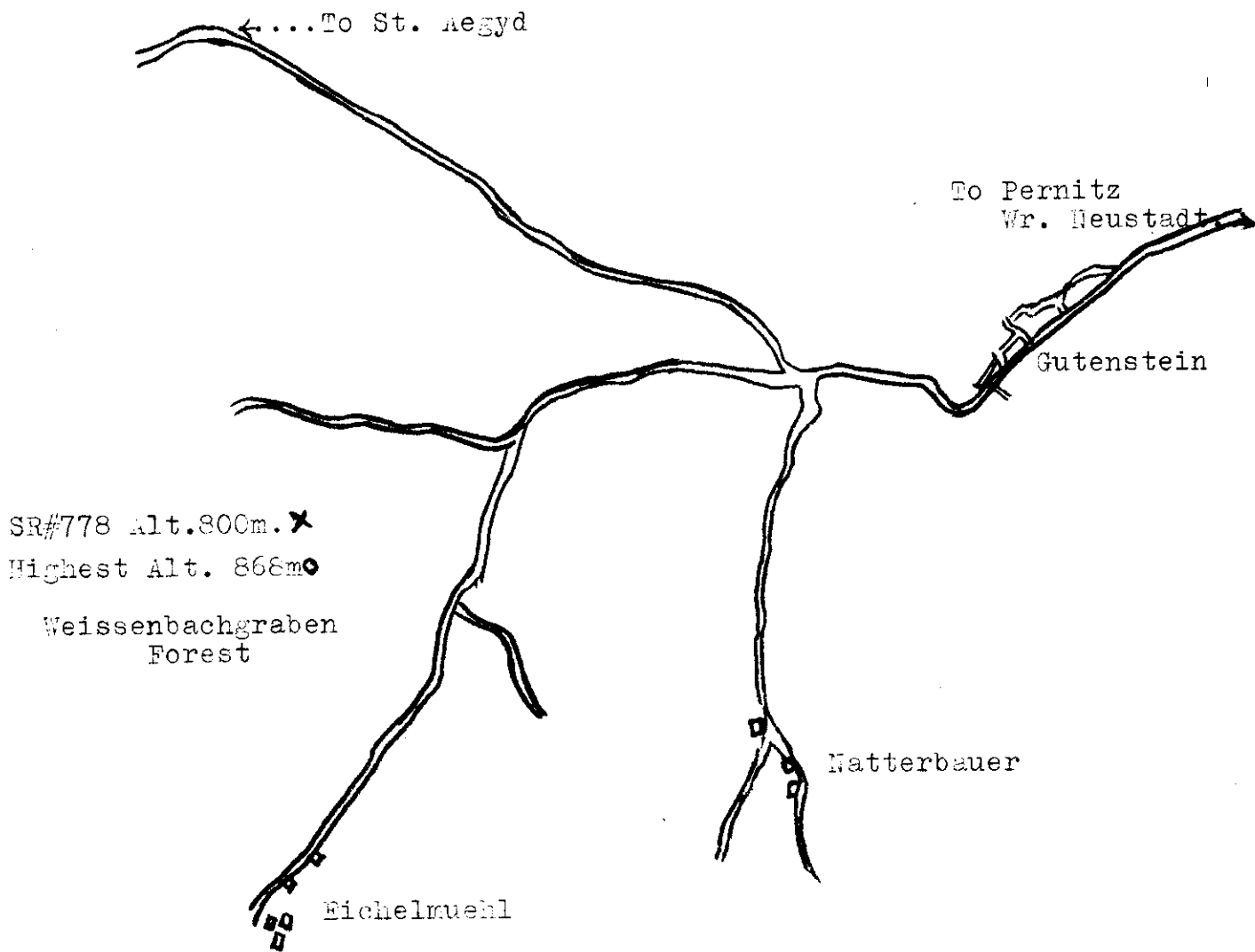

On 14 November 1954, the forest laborer Leopold Ranzenboeck from Gutenstein, Lorbeergasse # 2 discovered in the woods of the Weissenbachgraben - Community District Gutenstein - various human skeletal remains. At an examination of the place of discovery by district inspector Franz Haller of Post Gutenstein, a metal identification tag was found with the following inscription:

James C Young O-762860 T-43 -44 B P

At the place of discovery, skeletal remains of feet, arms, the spine and pelvic region as well as a portion of a jaw with several teeth were found lying. In addition, a pair of shoes containing small foot bones, and a thin insulated wire as well as small zippers and buckles, presumably from an airman's combination suit were discovered.

The identification tag was taken to the local post for safe-keeping. The place of discovery of the skeletal remains is known to the local post.

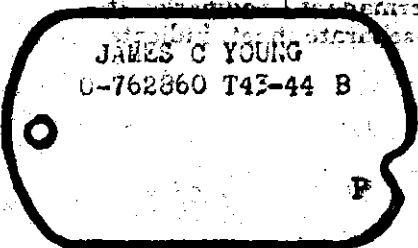
