- Date of death of X-198 is Unknown. Troops of the 92nd Division were engaged in combat activities in this area from October 1944 to April 1945, these dates being based on recovered casualties from the same Division and area.
- The listings for unrecovered casualties for this area and Division have been processed to eliminate all casualties from Units which were not in the vicinity of Strettoia, Italy
 - 4. Physical characteristics:



If no tag present, make notation of identifying data on form, protect in sealed bottle, canteen, spent shell, or best available container and bury with remains. If unidentified, take fingerprints of both hands; if this not possible, fill out tooth chart and note height, weight, color of eyes and hair tattoo marks, birthmarks, etc., and other data as serial no. of weapon, laundry marks, where body


