#### FACTS:

In a letter to this office of 4 March 1946 the following American dead were buried in isolated graves Map Ref. 019338 Sheet 88 IMOLA, Map of Italy 1/100,000.

- a. BERARD, Leo J. 31417155
- b. SANDERS, Charlie W. 34832390
- C. UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER Rank and Org., Unknown Date of death: Est. Dec. 1944.

### FINDINGS:

- On 8 March 1946 a Crew from this GRU. led by Pvt.Michael F. Gregorio went to vicinity of Vedriano (Map Ref. 019338 Sht. 88 IMOLA, Map of Italy 1/100,000) for the purpose of investigating isolated burials.
- Found graves with three white wooden crosses with these inscriptions:
  - a. AMERICAN SOLDIER BERARD, Leo J. 31417155 **T44** b. AMERICAN SOLDIER SANDERS, Charlie C. UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER . 34832390 T44
  - - 31 G.C.U was on the back of each marker.
- Found three bodies in one grave, one on top of the other, individually wrapped in blankets.
- 4. Identification tags were found with the following:
  - a. RERARD, Leo J. 2 Tags 31417155 b. SANDERS, Charlie W. 34832390 c. UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-235 2 Tags 34832390 No Tags
- 5. All bodies were found in skeleton form, fingerprints were impossible.

- 6. Remains of U.S. Army issue Clothing were found on these bodies, no markings, no sizes could be found.
- 7. Identification of Unknown American soldier X-235 was impossible tooth chart ref. to GRS form, Fingerprints impossible body in skeleton form.

#### RECOMMANDATIONS:

1. Being that Unknown American Soldier X-235 was found buriedwith the said American Soldier Leo J. Bererd, 31417155 and Charlie W. Sanders, 38832390, the list of missing in the area of operations be checked against the tooth chart of X-235.

#### COMMENTS:

- 1. It may be that Unknown American Soldier X-235 migh have been from same unit as above identified men.
  - 2. No other information was obtained.
  - 3. These bodies had been reburied by the British.







- 5. PERSONAL EFFECTS: List only personal effects taken from body on the Burnal Report form. Place these with information as to identity of owner, organization, emergency addressee, in personal effects bag, or wrap in handkerchief, towel, or other ava-
