



both of whom were members of the 350th Infantry Regiment, 88th Division. The body was in skeleton stage. No identifying marks were found on the G.I. clothing. Physical characteristics: light brown hair.

If no tag present, make notation of identifying data on form, protect in sealed bottle, canteen, spent shell, or best available container and bury with remains. If unidentified, take fingerprints of both hands, if this not possible, fill out tooth chart and note height, weight, color of eyes and han tattoo marks, birthmarks, etc..., and other data as serial no, of weapon, laundry marks, where body found, etc. Wrap body in shelter half, mattress cover, or blanket when available.
- 2. BURIAL · Dig grave to a depth of five feet (hasty battlefield burials, to sufficient depth to prevent elements from exposing the body) Place only one body in a grave. Dig graves side by side, row behind row.
- 3. MARKING OF GRAVE: Fasten identification tag to temporary name peg and pleace at head of grave. 
