LIEDICAL OFFICER'S REPORT OF INVESTIGATION OF RELAINS

1. The remains of "Believed to be Madison C. Eiland", taken from separate groves, (one from Castelafiorentino US Cemetary and one from Pietramala US Cemetary) were viewed, examined and compared with the remains of Unknown K-248 Grave # 4769 Castelfiorentino US Cemetary.

Dufficient deficiencies and duplications of osteological remains are present in these three remains which would allow of the three separate remains to be consolidated into only two remains. If this were accomplished, the two remains would then represent Two remains a (EILAND) plus EILAND2) plus (UNKNOWN X-248). The remains would have to be consolidated in the following manner in order that no incongruitles existed:


- a. Spine Eiland substituted for the 461/2 segments found with EILAND.
- b. The 461/2 segments Filand spine placed with unknown X-248.
- c. The heavy, thick ribs found with Elland2 be placed with Unknown X-248.
- d. The heavy, thick boned duplicated rt leg found with Filand be placed with Unknown X-248.

- 2. The probability, that the afformationed <u>free exchange</u> between the three remains is justified is based on similarities between bone size and character but the appearance of the bones at this late stage is not positive proof that only two individuals are represented. Therefore, in order that consolidation of these remains be justified certain points of directantial evidence must be clarified:
 - a. Do map coordinates at which the remains were initially recovered indicate that only the remains of two men were involved? Were they killed together or were they merely buried together? Were any more than two persons buried or killed together at this spot?
 - b. Do the Maxillary tooth fragments found with remains of Unknown K-248 compare, beyond a reasonable doubt, with the tooth chart of Eiland as recorded during life?
 - 1. If the maxillary fragments are from the skull of Elland, then we have justification for freely exphanging esteological remains and forming only two remains. If, however, the maxillary fragments are not preven beyond a reasonable doubt to be Ellands, then interchange of bones is based on supposition because; the increased size of the spine of Unknown X-248 and the large heavy ribs found in both Unknown X-248 and Elland indicate that they may be from the same person, but the last point cannot be proven beyond reasonable doubt by this officer.

RECOMMEND: That the remains involved in this investigation be kept in the Cemetary morgue pending decision your office, because of the chance of loss of parts of remains which often occurs in the unsatisfactory method of reburial in a mattress-cover as required by Army Regulations.



MEDICAL OFFICER'S REPORT OF INVESTIGATION OF REMAINS

1. The remains of "Believed to be Madison C. Eiland", taken from separate graves, (one from Castelafiorentino US Cemetary and one from Pietramala, US Cemetary) were viewed, examined and compared with the remains of Unknown X-248 Grave # 4769 Castelfiorentino US Cemetary.

Sufficient deficiencies and duplications of osteological remains are present in these three ramains which would allow of the three separate remains to be consolidated into only two remains. If this were accomplished, the two remains would then represent Two remains = (EILAND1 plus EILAND2) plus (UNKNOWN X-248). The remains would have to be consolidated in the following manner in order that no incongruities existed:

- a. Spine Eiland substituted for the 4&1/2 segments found with EILAND.
- b. The 4&1/2 segments Eiland spine placed with unknown X-248.
- c. The heavy, thick ribs found with Eiland² be placed with Unknown X-248.
- d. The heavy, thick boned duplicated rt leg found with Eiland be placed with Unknown X-248.

2. The probability, that the afformentioned <u>free exchange</u> between the three remains is justified is based on similarities between bone size and character but the appearance of the bones at this late stage is not positive proof that only two individuals are represented. Therefore, in order that consolidation of these remains be justified certain points of circumstantial evidence must be clarified:

- a. Do map coordinates at which the remains were initially recovered indicate that only the remains of two men were involved? Were they killed together or were they merely buried
 together? Were any more than two persons buried or killed
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- b. Do the Maxillary tooth fragments found with remains of Unknown X-248 compare, beyond a reasonable doubt, with the tooth chart of Eiland as recorded during life?
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RECOMMEND: That the remains involved in this investigation be kept in the Cemetary morgue pending decision your office, because of the chance of loss of parts of remains which often occurs in the unsatisfactory method of reburial in a mattress-cover as required by Army Regulations.


