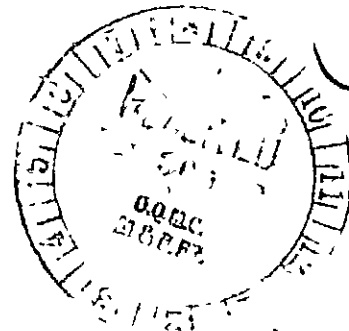

Remains interred as Unknown X-247 were segregated from remains interred in USMC Castelfiorentino as Unknown X-248 and USMC Pietramala, Plot 0, Row 20, Grave 1966, as Pvt Madison C Eiland, 33749529. These remains were simultaneously processed on 28 July 1949 in an effort to reestablish the identity of Pvt Eiland.

4. Report of Board Proceedings reestablishing the identity of Pvt Madison C Eiland in USMC Pietramala, Plot 0, Row 20, Grave 1966 is presently being prepared for Field Board action.

1. SUBMITTED HERewith IS A FIELD REPORT OF INVESTIGATION OF THIS OFFICE COVERING UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-248, REMAINS FOUND ON THE SURFACE OF THE EARTH IN THE VICINITY OF GESSO, ITALY. COORD: M(0.1-2.4) SHEET 11, MAP REF: 1/200.000.

2. **FACTS:**

THE INVESTIGATION TEAM WAS LED BY PFC. LABON R. JONES WENT TO THE ABOVE COORDINATE TO RECOVER SAID REMAINS.

3. **FINDINGS:**

A. REMAINS WERE FOUND ON THE SURFACE OF THE EARTH IN SKELETON FORM.

B. REMNANTS O.D. CLOTHING NO MARKINGS.

C. ONLY A PARTIAL TOOTH CHART WAS POSSIBLE BECAUSE PART OF MAXILLA, AND ALL OF THE MANDIBLE WAS MISSING.

4. **COMMENTS:**

REMAINS OF UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-248 WERE FOUND ABOUT 50 YARDS FROM THE REMAINS OF "BELIEVED TO BE" PVT. MADISON C. EILAND 73749526.

5. **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

THAT THE PARTIAL TOOTH CHART BE CHECKED WITH THE MISSING PERSONAL OF THE AREA OF THE CASUALTY.

6. **CONCLUSIONS:**

THE REMAINS OF UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-248 ARE NOW INTERRED IN PLOT 2-J, ROW 86, GRAVE 4769 AT THE U.S. MILITARY CEMETERY AT CASTELFIORENTINO, ITALY AND QMC FORM #1 GRs WILL BE FORWARDED TO YOUR HEADQUARTERS.

The skeletal remains of only one (1) man is now present in the grave.

Exchange of bones between original remains interred in this grave and "believed to be" Madison C. Biland, Plot 2-3, Row 86, Grave 4763, S. S. Military Cemetery, Castelfiorrentino; and remains of positively identified Madison C. Biland, Plot 0, Row 20, Grave 1966 ^{was described} based on study of bones for size, structure, color and articulation.

The skeletal remains of only two (2) men were found to be present in the combined three (3) graves.

Grave 4763, Row 86, Plot 2-3, "believed to be" Madison C. Biland is now a vacant grave.

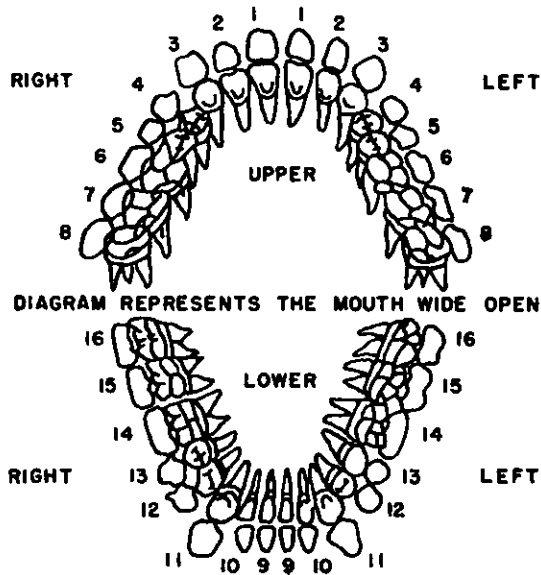


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN

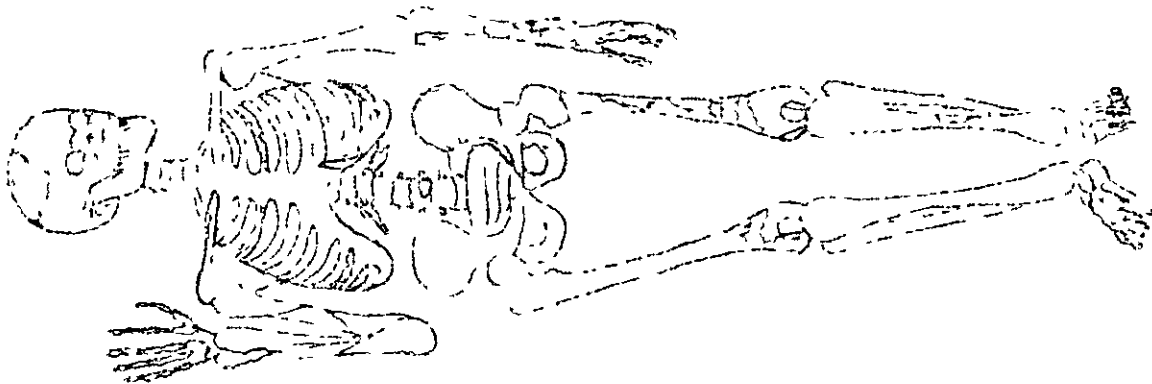
