1. Submitted herewith is a field report of investigation of this office covering UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-267 remains recovered two kilometres North of Strettoia, Italy. Coords. (97.0-94.0) Sheet 104. Map reference 1/100,000.

2. FACTS:

) , t

- A. Investigation team led by T/5 Tadashi Ishida went to the above mentioned coords. to recover remains of UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-267.
- B. The remains of body were reported by ADAMO BUSELLI, an Italian civilian who was acting as guide for our investigation team. The remains were found two kilometres North of Strettoia, Italy, exposed in a shallow hole assumed to be that of a shell crater.
- C. During combat elements of the 92nd Infantry Division had held the ground around this vicinity.
- D. Two days prior to the arrival of our investigation team to this area, an Italian civilian had his leg blown off by a mine while trying to recover an American rifle that was lying beside the remains of UNKNOWN AMERICAN SCLDIER Z-267. The serial number appearing on rifle was given to the men of the investigation team.
 - E. The initials AM were engraved on the stock of rifle.

3. FINDINGS:

- A. The remains of UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-267 were found exposed in a shallow hole two kilometres North of Strettoia, Italy.
 - B. The only remains found are listed as follows:

One dorsal vertebrae One left rib One right rib

C. The area within several hundred yards was thoroughly searched and carefully checked but no other remains of UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-267 could be traced. We are carrying these three (3) hones as those of one men.

- D. A helmet liner. cartridge belt and rifle were found.
- E. Markings found inside helmet liner (3631).
- F. Numbers appearing on rifle were SPRINGFIELD GARAND M-1 46627 on bridge, D36448-52-A-741 appeared on barrel.
 - G. Initials AM were engraved on stock.
- H. Tooth chart was impossible as head, mandible and maxilla were missing.
- I. No other identification pertaining to UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER x-267 could be found in the surrounding area.
- J. Estimations of height, weight and age hardly possible due to lack of remains.
- K. Remains assumed to be that of colored soldier due to finding of kinky black curly hair.

4. COMMENTS:

- As Request that marking appearing on helmet liner (3631) and numbers on M-1 rifle be checked for more positive identification.
- B. Qir ground forces casualty files have been carefully checked but did not reveal any pertinent information.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS:

A. It is recommended that we carry the three (3) bones as the remains of UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-267 until further identification can be established.

6. CONCLUSIONS:

The remains of UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER 3-267 are now interred in Plot 2-J. Row 91. Grave 4834 at the UNITED STATES MILITARY CEMETERY at CASTRIFICRENTINO, ITALY and QMC FORM #1 GRS will be forwarded to your headquarters.
