- 1. Submitted herewith is report of investigation concerning the recovery of the remains of X-275 and X-276.
- 2. Remains were recovered from a small gully or washes on the side of a steep slope at Coordinates 97-95 Sh. 104. Pisa Map of Italy 1/100.000, in the vicinity of Mt. Canala. The area just below the location where the bones were found was covered with thick foliage and brush end because that area was reputedly mined with wooden mines further search was deemed in edvisable. Remains were recovered by T/5 Ryo Uchida, 15 August 1946.
 - Excerpt from report submitted by T/5 Uchida is as follows:

"With the bones in the crevice were found bits of clothing. K-ration boxes and 30 cal. ammo but nothing in the vicinity could be found which established any identity other than that of American Ground Force personnel. When the mines have been cleared from that area I believe the search may be continued and possibly some more of the bones recovered. The guide informed me that in all probability the remains were those of a Negro soldier for during combat they had occupied that area. "

- 5. No clothing found, and no personal effects. Tooth chart was not accomplished as the head of neither body was recovered.
- 6. The remains have been interred as Unknown X-275, Flot 2-J. Row 93, Grave 4852 and Unknown X-276, Flot 2-J. Row 93, Grave 4853. U. S. Military Cemetery at Castelfiorentino and reports of interment will be forwarded with weekly report of 18-24 August 1946.


