1. Submitted herewith is a field report of investigation of this office covering "Believed to be": KITTRELL, Sampson (NMI) 14004009, remains recovered from the surface of the earth in the vicinity of Mt. Canala, Italy Coord: (98.4-97.2) Sheet 104 Map Ref: 1/100,000.

2. FACTS:

- A. The investigation team led by T/5 Tadashi Ishida went to the above mentioned coordinates to recover said American Soldier.
- B. Remains were found with aid of Civilians living near the area. These remains were found approximately 300 to 400 Yards from Unknown American Soldier X-268.
- C. Remains were found in area occupied by elements of the 92nd Infantry Division during combat.

3. FINDINGS:

A. After a complete and through search of the surrounding area, the only remains listed below were found.

Right Section Radius and ulna Part of the scapula Clavicle Lower part of femur Lower part of femur

Part of the cranium Patella

Lower part of ilium . Upper part of tibia

- B. Clothing: Remnants of US. Military raincoat with no markings found. Remnants of a German shirt found with remains, probably used to cover decease when was killed
 - C. One (1) identification tag found near the remains.
 - D. Partial tooth chart taken: teeth appeared in very

good condition, with the exception of 15 L. having a large cavity and 14 L.

E. It is estimated that "Believed to be": KITTRELL, Sampson (NMI) was 5' 8" in height, 170 Lbs., color of hair was black and curly. Estimated age 23 or 24.

4. COMMENTS:

A. No other information could be obtained from local civilians.

5. RECOMMANDATIONS:

A. That the partial tooth chart of "Believed to be": KITTRELL, Sampson (NMI) be checked with the dental records.

6. CONCLUSIONS:

The remains of "Believed to be": KITTRELL, Sampson (NMI) 14004009, are now interred in Plot 2-J, Row 91, Grave 4835 at the U.S. Military Cemetery at Castelfiorentino, Italy and QMC Form-#1-GRS will be forwarded to your Headquarters.


