1. Reference is made to Unknown X-5788, Evac #3829, the remains of whom were recovered at grid coordinates CT 25.7-32.4 map sheet 6628 IV.

2. At the time of recovery of subject decedent a belt, web, waist with buckle, bearing the name Walter Stipek, US 55 038 277, was found on the remains. An investigation conducted by this headquarters revealed that Cpl Stipek was rotated to the Zone of Interior 13 September 1952.

3. Request that Cpl Stipek be queried to determine who may have been in possession of the waist belt bearing his name and serial number.

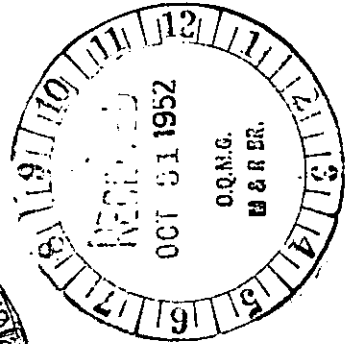
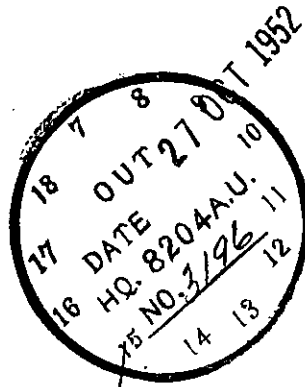
