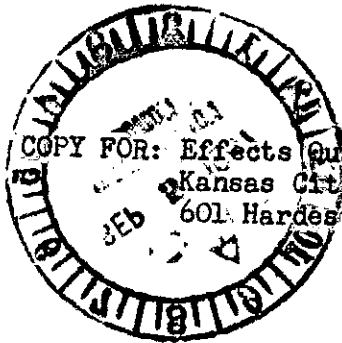
SUBJECT: Identification of Unknown Deceased

1. The remains interred in U.S. Military Cemetery Margraten, Holland, Plot PF, Row 11, Grave 256, have been identified from information available to this office as those of William H. MOONEY Jr., Capt., O-451859, Air Corps.
2. The expressed religious preference of the deceased was Protestant. The designated emergency addressee is his mother, Mrs. Elizabeth L. Mooney, Box #13, Hawkinsville, Georgia.
3. War Department records now indicate that the deceased was killed in action on 24 December 1944. The Report of Reburial submitted to this office has been amended.
