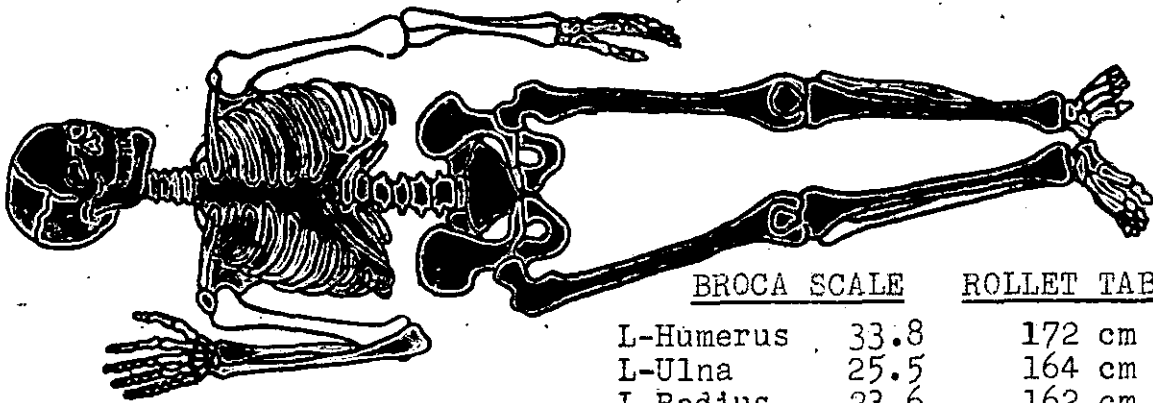

No ROI bottle, ID tags, personal effects or other means of identification found with remains. Two (2) humerus right and left, one (1) fibula, one (1) ulna and one (1) radius of remains only received. Estimated weight of remains, 1 1/2 lbs.  
 The physical height is approximately 5'7-5/8. According to original ROI, canteen bottle bearing the inscription of "MAX MAHONE" found with remains, but no canteen bottle was received.

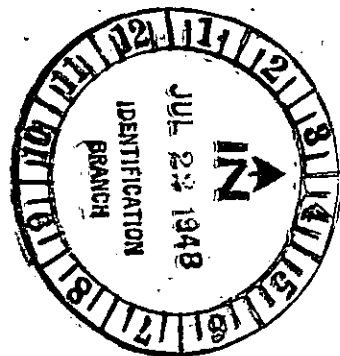
