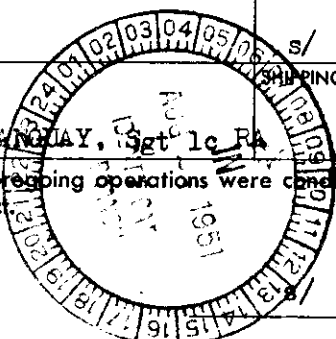

enemy plane at 1410, 12 November 1944, while anchored at  
San Pedro Bay, off east coast of Leyte. Resulting action

ignited a quantity of gasoline stored on deck, spilling it over the deck and into the hold  
where the personnel were quartered.

Reports received from the Field AGHE, indicates certain of the personnel were identi-  
fied and others buried in Tacleban cemetery as Unknowns; later the remains were removed  
to USAF Cemetery Leyte and presently are stored in a Mausoleum at Manila.

A review of the Reports of Burial for deceased originally interred as Unknowns,  
against records of decedents not yet identified lead to the identification of your husband.  
The height shown on the reports of burial for the Unknowns recovered from the SS Jeremiah  
M. Daily were all compared against the height of your husband and remains interred in Grave  
8108, compared very favorably, all others proved unfavorable. The tooth chart submitted  
with the Unknown report of burial indicated 5 very small fillings and a few cavities.  
Available dental information for your husband was not complete and dental comparison was not  
accomplished.

In order to further substantiate the identification it would be greatly appreciated  
if you could furnish this Office with a civilian dental chart of your husband".

BASIS FOR DECLARING REMAINS IDENTIFIABLE

- MAR 23 1949
1. Dk. Engr. Carroll S. LARSON, Z-369261 is reported in casualty report to have died on 12 November 1944 aboard the "SS Jeremiah M. Daily" in San Pedro Bay, Leyte, P. I.
  2. a. According to version of Capt. George B. Vinson, Commanding Officer of the 3483 Ord MAM Co., in his report dated 8 September 45, "SS Jeremiah M. Daily" was bombed and crash dived by an enemy plane at 1410, 12 November 1944 while anchored at San Pedro Bay off east coast of Leyte awaiting debarkation. Resulting action ignited a quantity of gasoline stored on deck, spilling it over the deck and into the hold where the personnel were quartered. (See Incl. 6).  
b. In the same report Capt. Vinson further states "missing man could have been one of the 20 to 30 unidentified bodies removed from the ship and buried in the U. S. Military Cemetery, Tacloban, Leyte, P. I.". (See Incl. 6).
  3. ROI and ROS for UNKNOWN X-3260 show that remains were recovered from USAF Cemetery, Tacloban #1, Leyte, P. I. (See Incls. 1, 2, 4 and 5).
  4. Place and date of death indicated on ROI and ROS for UNKNOWN X-3260 are in agreement with data on OCMG Form 371 for Dk. Engr. LARSON. Cause of death on ROI specifically states "KIA-3rd degree burns, body mutilated, result of enemy bombing." At CIP, top of skull of remains was found to be charred. A small fracture was found on right side of the frontal bone which could possibly be a bullet hole. (See Incls. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5).
  5. Dental chart on OMC Form 1044a for UNKNOWN X-3260 is in agreement with dental chart on OCMG Form 371 for Dk. Engr. LARSON. (See Incls. 1 and 3 item 18).
  6. Estimated height indicated on OMC Form 1044 is in agreement with height shown on OCMG Form 371 for UNKNOWN X-3260. (See Incls. 1 and 3 item 9).

7. Identification data for all the other remains with the same or similar circumstances of death were compared with OQMG Form 371 for Dk. Engr. LARSON with negative results.

8. OQMG Forms 371 for the other casualties on the "SS Daily" were checked against the identification data for UNKNOWN X-3260 with negative results.

9. It is therefore recommended that the remains of UNKNOWN X-3260, AGRS Mausoleum, Manila, P. L., Hangar 813, Bay J, Crypt 3358, be identified as those of Dk. Engr. Carroll S. LARSON, Z-369261.
