

13.	RE ARKS: (SEE REVERSE SIDE) Party departed from Dipi at 1000 hours, 28 April 1947, by Motor, arriving at Sabanale at 1100; travel by motor from this point was impossible, so the party continued North on foot. All Civilians on the

route of travel were questioned regarding any possible American remains in the area.

On arijving at Lomonon, a search was made for the graves of CHANLEY and CLSON. Nothing was found and none of the Civilians in the Vicinity had knowledge of any possible burial near the barrio. On further questioning of local civilians, leads were found on 3 possible remains about 5 Kilometers East of Lomonon. Each was checked, but proved to be unburied Japanese.

The night of 28 April was spent in the local schoolroom.

On 29 April, the party was divided into 2 crews. One crew of 2 EM and one civilian guide departed to search the area in the vicinity of Mt. Agobob. The second crew of 1 EM, 2 Civilians (guides) and one Officer continued North up the Coast. All C. vilians on the route were questioned, but no further leads were found until, arriving at Villaba, one trip about 4 kilometers east of Villaba, but the remains proved to be Japanese. The night of 29 April, was spent in Villaba.

On 30 April, guided by Juan Comonol, a Barrio Policeman, 3 recoveries were made:

GRID COORD: 110 12' N., 1240 24' E - unburied but complete skeleton, no Identification except buttons from fatigue clothing.

GRID COORD: 11° 13' 15" N., 124° 24' 30" E - unburied, but complete skeletop, no Identification except buttons, minor scrap of American equipment. About a year previous, some Civilians in the area had picked up a crucifix from the body. The crucifix was recovered, but had no Identification markings.

GRED GOORD: 11° 13' 15" N., 124° 24' E - unburied, but complete skeleton and one dog tag bearing the following information:



The recovered remains were returned with one EM and one civilian, who spent the night of 30 April in Villaba, returned to Palempon by boat and truck to DIFI.

The balance of the search team, one officer and one guide, continued the search, traveling East to Taob and South thru Hibuluangan, Bugabuga, Sulpa, Agobob and back to Dipl. Civilians were questioned on the entire route, but no further information could be found.

It is the opinion of the undersigned that further search of this area would be futile.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPER MARKINGS ON DENTAL CHART

1. Give all information and description on dental chart as nearly correct as the condition of the body will allow. There are 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by ne numbers on the chart. Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting) teeth), cuspids or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspids (chewing teeth), and molars(principal chewing teeth). An examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions: lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridgework, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jaws found.
