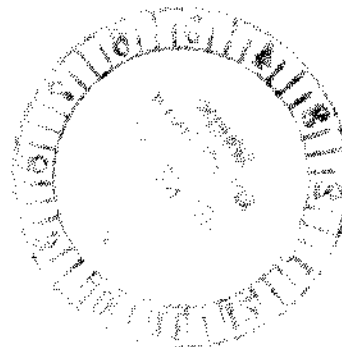

Baptisto, No RANK, No ASN shown, interred in Grave 7278, Leyte #1, Philippine Islands (formerly interred Plot 1, Row 19, Grave 370, USAF Cemetery Cebu #2, Cebu, Philippine Islands).
