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

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

I, police Sgt, Faustino Hupayan of the barrio of Pangantocan, Bukidnon, make the following statement:

That one day in March of 1947 as I was patrolling my area about 15 kilometers east of the Barrio, I found some bones laying on the trail. I began to look around and a short distance from the trail I found a grave that had been dug up by wild pigs.

That while looking around I found a bracelet laying in the grave which had the name of Sgt Parkerton on it. There was also parts of the blanket an intrenching shovel and ration cans laying around.

That just as soon as I came in off patrol, I told the chief of Police what I had found. And just as soon as the Grave Registration came in this area, he went and told them what I had seen.

That I took the bracelet that had Sgt Parkerton's name of it and erased his name and put my name on it.

That to the best of my knowledge and the evidence that was around the grave it is my belief that the remains are that of an American soldier.

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPER MARKINGS ON DENTAL CHART

1. Give all information and description on dental chart as nearly correct as the condition of the body will allow. There are 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by ne numbers on the chart. Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting) teeth), cuspids or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspids (chewing teeth), and molars(principal chewing teeth). An examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions: lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridgework, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jaws found.



Dentures (Plates) Draw diagram of relative size and shape of plate block in teeth attached and indicate retaining clasps on natural teeth with the word "clasp".


