S T A T E M E N T

Discrepancy on SIMMONS Garfield W. cleared as height and dental chart comparison with Form 371 was favorable.

The extra remains were removed from SIMMONS Garfield W. and assigned Manila Mausoleum Unknown X-4984.

These cases should be cross-referenced with UNKNOWN X-2840, DITTO, John S., SENIOR, Edward, UNKNOWN X-2835 and UNKNOWN X-2813. Only three (3) of the six (6) crew members were originally identified namely; SIMMONS, DITTO and SENIOR, however the CIP recommended that Manila Mausoleum UNKNOWN X-2840 should be identified as VICKS, UNK. X-2813 be identified as LUCAS and UNK. X-2835 be identified as KRAYBILL.

CONCLUSION:

If the CIP's recommendations for identification of the three (3) crew members is approved, it is suggested that the extra remains, now designated UNKNOWN X-4984 should be declared as an unmanifested passenger and buried as and Unknown.
