
Remains of ANTHONY L. COCUZZO reprocessed because of presence of one extra portion of remains and a deviation of ASN. Forms 79 and 371 of Cocuzzo were used for verification.

Upon processing, it was revealed that the one skull with the maxilla and mating mandible compared favorably for Cocuzzo. Structural continuity of this skull and the large bones is considered sufficient evidence to warrant re-establishing identification even though there was a slight difference in estimated height of remains. The correct serial number is 31 157 770 as shown on Form 371 and original identification tag.

The extra one remains segregated was assigned Manila Museum Unknown X-4577.

This statement is attached to case papers of Cocuzzo, Anthony L. and Unknown X-4577 for cross reference.
