1. A review of our records reveals that Unknown X-721, Leyte No. 1, was initially interred in USAF Cemetery Tacloban No. 2 (Grave 357) as X-41 and subsequently reinterred in USAF Cemetery Leyte No. 1 (Grave 1178) as X-43.

2. Corrected Report of Storage in question indicates former Leyte No. 1 grave number as "357" and not "537" as referred to in basic communication. Same report, however, is in error and should have indicated "1178" as the former Leyte No. 1 grave number.

3. Consequent to the above findings and in compliance with paragraph 3 of basic communication, a corrected Report of Storage for Unknown X-721, Leyte No. 1, has been accomplished and is herewith submitted to replace the previous corrected report dated 9 June 1949.
