It was assumed that the Chaplain buried the man in a USAF Cemetery on the island, but since the condolence file is incomplete and the Chaplain has returned to the US, no record exists as to the place of burial. The chance of an isolated burial would appear small because the man from whom we acquired the foregoing information saw the man wounded and evacuated to the medics.

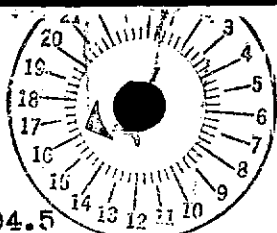

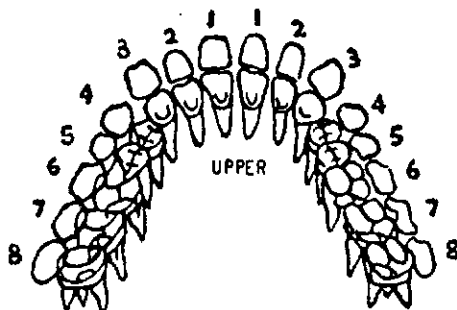
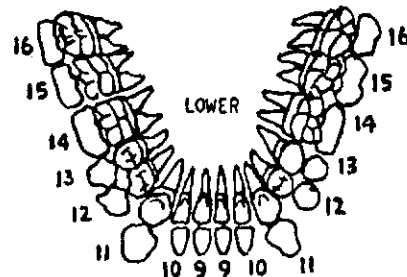
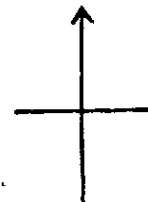


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN
