1 Major Lay MEMO FOR 5 Feb 1. Unknown X-20, USAF Cemetery Tacloban #1, Leyte,  
 Regis Br RECORD 1953 was interred 4 November 1944. These remains were later  
 Mem Div moved to USAF Cemetery Leyte #1 and renumbered Unknown  
 X-164.

2. On 9 January 1948, Unknown X-164 USAF Leyte #1 was reprocessed and determined to be the remains of two men. The remains were stored as Unknown X-3326A and Unknown X-3326B AGRS Mausoleum, Manila. At about the same time, Unknown X-168, USAF Leyte #1 was determined by processing to consist of portions of three individuals. One portion stored as Unknown X-3257C, AGRS Mausoleum, Manila was determined to be a portion of Unknown X-3326B and these two portions of remains were consolidated under the latter Unknown X number thus eliminating the former unknown number.

3. On 25 May 1949, this Office approved the identification of Unknown X-3326A AGRS Mausoleum, Manila, as the remains of PFC Harold O. Woodruff, 35739113.

4. On 10 August 1949, the AGRS Philippines took action to renumber Unknown X-3326B, AGRS Manila Mausoleum as Unknown X-3326 AGRS Manila Mausoleum.

5. On 2 December 1949, AGRS Philcom Zone issued an unidentifiable certificate for Unknown X-164, USAF Cemetery Leyte #1 for the remains previously recorded as Unknown X-3326, AGRS Mausoleum Manila, thereby returning the remains to a former number under which they had been carried.

6. On 30 January 1950, AGRS Philcom Zone having on hand a disinterment directive for Unknown X-164, USAF Cemetery Leyte #1 interred these remains in Fort McKinley, Plot "A", Row 7, Grave 20.

7. On 15 March 1950, after some difficulty in obtaining disposition instructions, a disinterment directive was cut for the remains of Harold O. Woodruff and this disinterment directive was marked to show "previously Unknown #-164, Leyte #1, Philippine Islands". It should be borne in mind that the portion of Unknown X-164 which had been carried under Unknown X-3326A, AGRS Mausoleum Manila is not the same remains as Unknown X-164, Leyte #1, Philippine Islands previously carried as Unknown X-3326B, AGRS Mausoleum Manila.

SUBJECT: Identification of World War II Deceased

2. The above named deceased were killed in action 3 November 1944 when the transport SS Mathew P. Deady was attacked by an enemy suicide airplane while anchored in Tacloban Bay, Leyte, P.I. The complete casualty list as prepared by AGO 21 May 1945 is believed to be accurate, however, it does not agree with the number of casualties reported by the U. S. Navy 15 June 1944. It is quite possible that other deceased still carried as missing in action were casualties aboard this ship.

3. In the two individual identifications recommended the identifications are based entirely on the available Army dental records of the deceased. Under the circumstances which surround the entire incident it is considered that this basis does not warrant conclusive individual identifications.

4. Two Navy personnel, S 1/c J:ta L. Corbell, 8860299, and S 1/c Robert W. Lollar, 8718295, were declared missing in action after the bombing of the Deady. Remains have never been recovered and identified as being those of these decedents. Form 371 for the two deceased are inclosed herewith.

5. As stated in paragraph #2, above, there is some doubt as to the actual number of casualties from this incident. Furthermore, it is known that some personnel aboard the Deady jumped overboard in an attempt to save themselves. It is quite possible that bodies washed up on the shore after the incident were, in fact, deceased from the Deady.
