

DISAPPROVAL OF FIELD BOARD FINDINGS

Field Board Findings received recommending the individual identification of Unknown X-3422 as Pfc. Troy B. Lusby, 18170065.

Records of AGO indicate that Pfc. Troy B. Lusby was killed in action 25 October 1944 in the South West Pacific.

On 25 October 1944 an ICS with Pfc. Lusby a member of a combat patrol of 12 embarked at Tacloban, Leyte Province, P.I., on a mission to proceed northermost edge of Leyte then south to Leyte along a trail paralleling the strait.

In 1945 a Search and Recovery Team disinterred remains buried 29th October 1944 as Unknown X-1 in USAF Cemetery, Tacloban #1, Leyte, P.I., and transferred them to USAF Cemetery, Leyte #1, where they were redesignated Unknown X-181. Remains are now stored at AGRS Mausoleum, Manila, P.I., as Unknown X-3422.

Case concerning Unknown X-3422 recommended for identity as Pfc. Troy B. Lusby is being submitted for disapproval for the following reasons:

- (a) Army dental records for Pfc. Lusby show fillings on R-15, L-14 and L-15. Dental chart accomplished for Unknown X-3422 show no indication of R-15, L-14 and L-15 being filled.
- (b) Lt. Col. Kerr states that Pfc. Lusby was standing in the passenger well, at very nearly the exact point of impact of the bomb. Skeleton chart accomplished for Unknown X-3422 indicates that body was not mangled.

It is therefore recommended that these Board Proceedings be disapproved and upon concurrence the Field will be advised of disapproval.
