1. Reference is made to Reports of Interment for the remains of Unknowns X-335, X-336 and X-713, USAF Cemetery Leyte #1, interred in Fort McKinley, P.I., as unidentifiable.

2. Investigation indicates that the remains of Unknowns X-335 and X-336 may be identifiable as Pvt Robert A. Russellk, 39327076 and Pfc Frank Enos, 31292965, respectively.

3. The remains of Unknowns X-335 and X-336 were recovered from the vicinity of Lubi, Leyte, and interred December 1945 in the USAF Cemetery Leyte #1, P.I. The processing of Unknown X-336 in the AGRS Mausoleum Manila, revealed that portions of two decedents were represented and the very partial remains for the second decedent were segregated and designated as Unknown X-713. A comparison of the skeletal charts for the remains of Unknown X-335 and X-713, indicates that the skeletal remains of Unknown X-713 may be the missing portions of the skeletal remains of Unknown X-335.

4. Pfc Enos and Pvt Russell, both members of Company G, 118th Glider Infantry, were reported killed in action on 25 December 1944. The patrol of which they were members was ambushed by the Japanese approximately two miles northwest of Lubi, Leyte, P.I.

5. The dental chart accomplished for the remains of Unknown X-335 compares almost identically with Army dental records for Pvt Russell, but the estimated height for the remains compares more favorably with Pfc Enos' recorded height. The dental chart accomplished for the remains of Unknown X-336 compares very favorably with Pvt Enos' dental records, but the estimated height for the remains compares more favorably with Pvt Russell's recorded height.
