

This Bureau is trying to identify an unknown body that was recovered from an isolated burial at Pinctan, Panaon Island, P. I. These remains were reported to be those of a sailor. The body was buried at a depth of four feet, with bamboo cross at the head. No identification was found in the grave or on the cross. One lower leg bone was broken. Burial was made by Estanislao Ylan, 3rd Lt., Bluetail Guard. 


