1. The following is a sketch and examination of a dental plate found with Unknown X-39.



Lingual Bar of Stainless Steel.

The lingual part of clasps were of vulcanite. The labial part of clasps were of stainless steel. The base of the partial was constructed of light

red vulcanite rubber.

The upper partial was constructed of the same base material as the lower. It was a palital bar partial-but the bar was missing. The one remaining clasp was a babial finger clasp of stainless steel. The upper right side was all that was found and it replaced the upper right second molar.

- 2. The Plate is apparently of civilian design.
- 3. Considering the condition and type of the plate it can be assumed that the owner was between 35 and 40 years of age.


