Unknown X-455 grave 3152 - In my opinion there are in this grave the remains of more than one boly. There is in addition to the two known Pemurs the head of a third. Also a bone rescubling a third Pemur without either articulating surface intact. Beside the two definite Radii there is also a shaft of a third. All other homes in this grave seem to be correlated to each other in pairs or mouns.

Unknown K-527 grave 51:3 - The remains of this grave constitute more than those of one person. Besides matching femure - coccyx and radii there are 2 Femure, 2 Knee articulations of 2 Tibias one coccyx, and the articulation from a Fibula. Will other bones appear to be those of one person.


