#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPER MARKINGS ON DENTAL CHART

I. Give all information and description on dental chart as nearly correct as the condition of the body will allow. There are 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by ne numbers on the chart. Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting) teeth), cuspide or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspide (chewing teeth), and molars(principal chewing teeth), an examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions: lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridgework, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jams found.



Dentures (Plates) Draw diagram of relative size and shape of plate block in teeth bentures and indicate retaining clasps on matural teeth with the word "clasp".
