The above mentioned soldier was acting as an assistant squad leader, Third Platoon, Company "G", 182d Infantry, during an attack on a series of hills to the West of Lahug Air Strip, Cebu, Philippine Islands, on the 28 March 1945. When a terrific enemy mortar barrage forced our troops to withdraw due to heavy casualties, Private Kemp was reported wounded and sent in for treatment. However, after returning to a re-organization point late at night, and a check was made with the Battalion Aid Station, no record of the soldier's return was located; but we were informed that he might possibly have cleared through an other unit. Several days later a check was made of all the hospitals known to be on the island, but no records of his whereabouts were obtained.

On 28 March 1945, Private First Class Henry L. Kemp, ASN 37620607, was acting as an assistant squad leader of the Third Platoon, Company "G", 182d Infantry, during an attack on a series of hills West of the Lahug Airstrip, Cebu, Philippine Islands.

A terrific mortar barrage forced our troops to withdraw due to heavy casualties. Pfc Kemp was reported wounded in action and was sent to the rear for treatment.

After the remainder of the Company returned to a re-organization point later that evening, a check was made through the Second Battalion, 182d Infantry Medical Aid station and were informed that no record of his (Kemp's) admittance was listed. A further check was made through all medical units and hospitals on the island and still we could secure no information of Pfc Kemp's disposition.

Considering the above mentioned facts we are forced to believe that Private First Class Henry L. Kemp should be listed as Missing in Action.

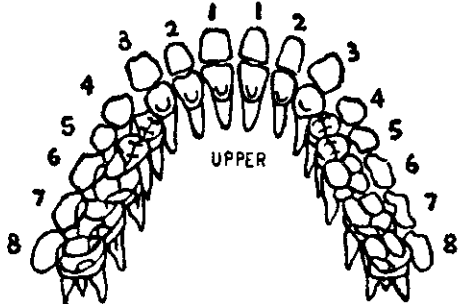
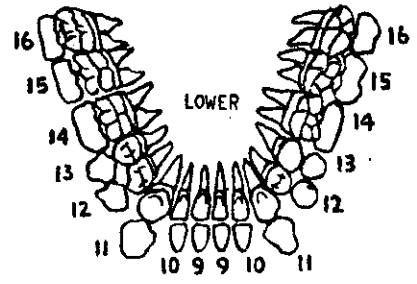
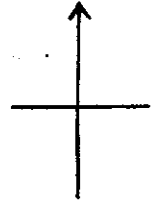


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN

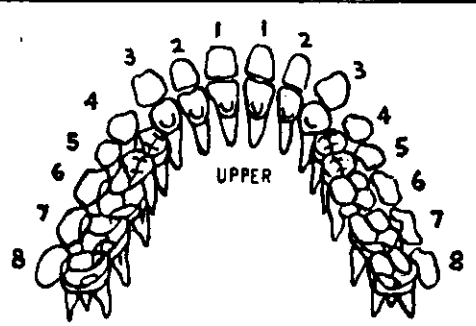
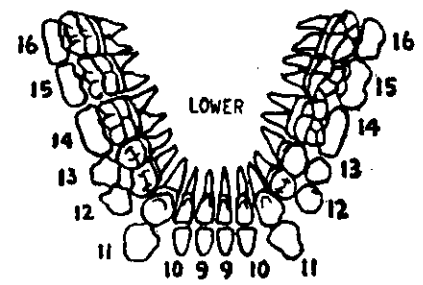


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN

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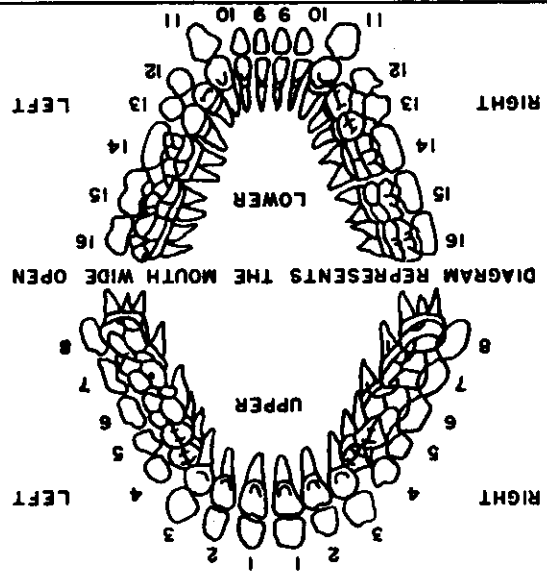


On the 17th of January 1947, a search party composed of Pfc Ralph L. Vernon and Pvt Lawrence Tomei left the FS-170, which was docked at Cebu City, mission: Recovery of the remains of Pfc Henry L. Kemp, reported located in the mountains north of Lahug Airstrip.

Natives living in that vicinity informed the party that they knew of a grave of an American soldier at the crest of a hill overlooking the airstrip. The party proceeded to the grave disinterred the remains, and returned them to the FS-170. The remains were in very good condition with very few of the bones missing. The skull was complete with both upper and lower jaw and very few teeth missing.

Remains were recovered at polar coordinates: 10° 20' 50" North Latitude; 128° 52' 45" East Longitude.


