1. Proceedings of the Field Board of Review, dated 23 April 1949, recommending that Unknown I-3669, AGRS Mausoleum, Manila, P.I., (formerly Unknown X-92, USAF Cemetery #1, Leyte, P.I.) be identified as S/Sgt. Efrain T. Pena, 38073542, are returned herewith disapproved for the following reasons:

a. Even though the dental chart for Unknown X-3669 is not contradictory with Army dental records for S/Sgt. Efrain T. Pena, 38073542, this would not justify identification as the tooth chart does not have any outstanding peculiarities for comparison. Due to the numerous casualties sustained in this area, identification could only be established by an unusually strong dental comparison.

b. Documentary evidence presented does not establish the basis for associating the remains of Unknown X-3669 with S/Sgt. Efrain T. Pena, 38073542.

2. It is requested that further investigation be conducted in an effort to establish the identification of subject Unknown.

RECOMMENDATION FOR DISAPPROVAL OF FIELD BOARD FINDINGS

Field recommends that the remains of Unknown X-3669 be identified as S/Sgt. Efrain T. Pena, 38073542.

S/Sgt Pena, a member of Company A, 127th Infantry Regiment, was seriously wounded in action by machine gun fire at Bagaba, Leyte, on 25 December 1944, and died the following day at the 1st Battalion Aid Station. The Bagaba referred to above is probably Bagabao since Bagaba is not listed in the gazetteer.

According to information received from the Army Ground Forces Historical files, the 127th Regiment moved out of the Libongao-Humaybunay area on 24 December 1944. Leaving Agayayan the following day, the Regiment encountered no opposition until approximately 1530 hours when it met and engaged in battle approximately 300 Japanese. S/Sgt Pena was seriously wounded in this encounter. Casualty Report No. 234, Hq 32d Infantry Division, dated 11 January 1945, reported this casualty as having occurred near Bagaba on 25 December 1944.

Remains of Unknown X-3669 were recovered from the Limon area and interred as Unknown X-4, USAF Cemetery #1, Limon, and later as Unknown X-92, USAF Cemetery #1, Leyte. It is noted that at the time of original interment, members of the 126th Infantry Regiment killed in action on 28 November 1944, were buried on the left and right sides of S/Sgt Pena. Original Reports of Interment and all subsequent Reports of Interment indicate that the date of death was either estimated to be or to be 28 November 1944.

The dental chart for Unknown X-3669, while not contradictory, is not considered to be sufficiently in agreement with that of S/Sgt Efrain T. Pena, 38073542, to justify an identification.

Dental and physical data for S/Sgt Pena were compared against corresponding data for all unknowns recovered from that area with negative results.

Documentary evidence is considered insufficient to associate remains of Unknown X-3669 with S/Sgt Efrain T. Pena, 38073542, especially in view of the numerous casualties sustained in this area.

It is recommended that the identification of Unknown X-3669, as proposed by the Field, be disapproved.

*This seems to be just an "area" association, while there is nothing actually contradictory there isn't anything strong enough to prove the identification.*

The deceased, Pfc. Dennis Hogan Jr., to whom you refer was not a member of my platoon at the time of his death.

I was away from the Company at the time the bodies were recovered from Mt. Suloc, and did not view the remains.

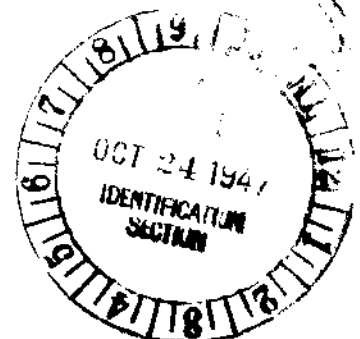
All of the bodies recovered from Mt. Suloc were buried at Batangas, P.I. Pfc. Hogan was killed in a close area with other members of his platoon. It is almost certain that his body was recovered and buried at Batangas. However, I did not personally identify any of the remains and I understand that even close friends of the deceased had difficulty in establishing positive identity.

Pfc. Hogan was killed by enemy rifle and machine gun fire in the attack of a fortified position on Mt. Suloc Batangas, P.I. His body along with the other dead of his platoon and company were not recovered until the position was taken by other forces about seven or eight days later.

Regret that I cannot give you more concrete information.
