3. It is requested that the records of your office and the inscription on the grave marker be changed accordingly and this office advised upon completion thereof.

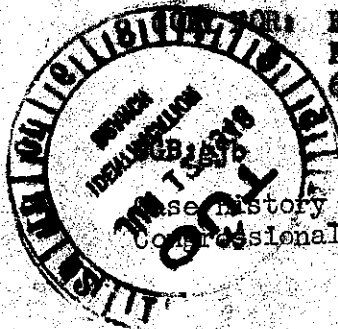
