1. A recent investigation conducted to recover the remains of several Philippine Scouts interred in the Bataan Memorial Cemetery, Mt. Samat, Pilar, Bataan, Philippines, resulted in the accidental disinterment of the remains of Unknown X-2, Manila #1 (X-1369 AGRS Mausoleum, Manila).

2. After a thorough scrutiny of subject remains, our investigator brought the remains to our Central Identification Laboratory for processing and possible association with an unknown American casualty. In the opinion of the investigator, the remains had the characteristics of a white man.


3. The processing resulted in the findings that subject remains are those of an individual with physical characteristics indicating race as white. QMC Form 1044 has been accomplished and herewith forwarded, in duplicate, for your further reference. Based on the anthropologist's findings, it is apparent that subject remains should not have been returned to allied control.

4. Subject Unknown is listed as one of the remains turned over to Philippine authorities on 12 April 1948 for final disposition. However, the basis for the transfer of custody of UNKNOWN X-2 Manila #1 cannot be determined by this Headquarters at the present time in view of the unavailability of records pertaining to this Unknown. A check with the Philippine Army Graves Registration Service likewise produced negative results.

5. No further action is being contemplated by this Headquarters to effect the final disposition of this Unknown until additional information or copies of pertinent burial records are received from your Headquarters or from the Office of the Quartermaster General.

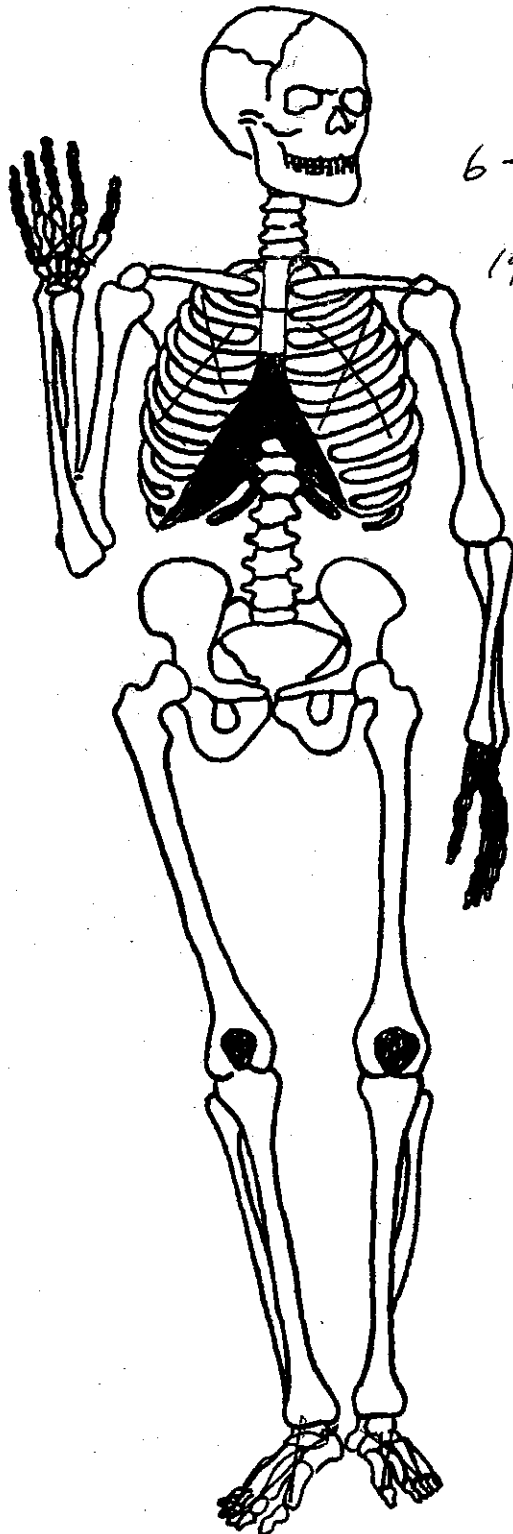

1. A review of the storage reports for Unknowns X-3957 and X-1369, AGRS Mausoleum, Manila, P. I., indicates the following findings:

a. Unknown X-1369 (formerly Unknown X-2, USAF Cemetery Manila No. 1) was stored in Hangar 812, Bay J, Crypt 3141, on 31 October 1947, and was subsequently turned over to the Philippine Government on 12 April 1948.

b. Unknown X-3957 (formerly Unknown X-187, USAF Cemetery Finschhafen No. 3) was stored in the same storage location (Hangar 812, Bay J, Crypt 3141) on 9 March 1948.

2. From the above information, it will be noted that the storage of Unknown X-3957 took place prior to the transfer of custody of Unknown X-1369. However, those remains turned over to the Philippine Government including Unknown X-1369, were removed from their respective storage locations prior to the actual shipment in order to allow enough time necessary in the preparation and casketing of the remains. Hence, the former storage location of Unknown X-1369 was reoccupied by Unknown X-3957 after it had been vacated by the former even prior to the actual transfer of the remains of the former.
