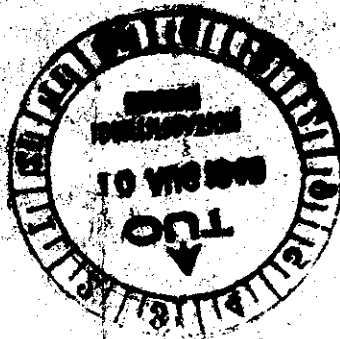

This man accompanied the Investigation Party to a place about 20 meters from the fork of the street beyond the Balanga bridge in the direction of the town of Pilar. The place is under bamboo grooves near the bank of the Balanga River.

- LT NIEVES - Did you see any American soldiers buried in this place?
- DILIG - When we arrived here after the Japs had left, I saw the legs and shoes of a soldier sticking out of this hole.
- N - Do you know when he was buried here?
- D - No sir. When we arrived here we just saw him here.
- N - When did you first see the body?
- D - I do not remember, but it was after the surrender of Bataan and after the soldiers left this place to continue their march. That must be around April, 1942.
- N - How did you know the body was that of an American?
- D - The shoes were big and the lower limbs were long. Besides, I dug up the body and wrapped it in a fish trap and reinterred it here.
- N - Do you think the body of that soldier is still here?
- D - The body was covered, so I think it is still here.
- N - Did you find anything on the ground belonging to the man buried here that will lead us to know the name of the soldier?
- D - I did not find anything; I only saw that the soldier was dressed in khaki uniform.
- N - Do you know of any other place where the Americans were buried?
- D - Yes sir, I know of another place where two Americans were buried.
- N - When were they buried?
- D - Probably at the same time that this soldier in this grave was buried. They were buried by the Philippine Army soldiers.
- N - Can you tell us how we can identify them?
- D - We cannot tell you because that was already a long time ago.
- N - Were you here when they were buried?
- D - No sir, we were driven away by the Japs. We just saw the bodies when we arrived here.
- N - Are you sure they are American soldiers.
- D - Yes sir.
- N - Can you accompany us to that place someday?
- D - Yes sir.

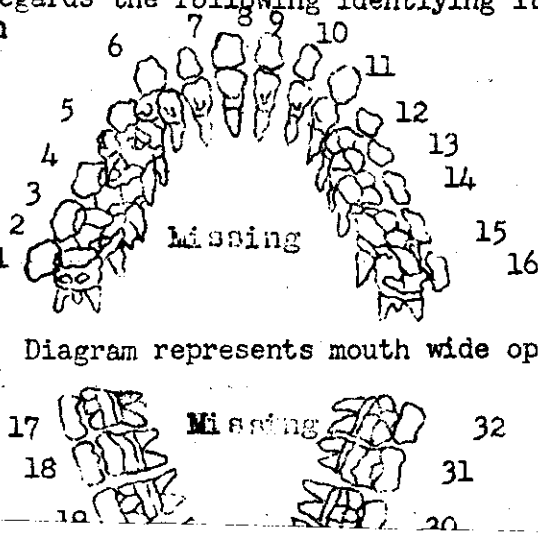


Diagram represents mouth wide open
