- 1. In compliance with the above-referenced radio, forwarded herewith is copy of 1044 case papers dated 10 October 1949 pertaining to the remains designated Unknown X-3896, Marila Mausoleum (formerly Unknown X-1290, Manila #2.)
- 2. Records indicate that this Unknown was previously assigned Unknown Number X-3896-A and further that X-3896-A and X-3896-B were designated 27 February 1945, at the time of the original processing of Unknown X-1290, Yanila %2. The 293 file for X-3896-A indicates that the suffix letter was dropped and that this remains was interred in Fort McKinley Cemetery as an Unidentifiable. The 293 file for X-3896-B indicates that 1044 case papers were not prepared for this remains and further that X-3896-B was assigned CIL Number 323 and interred in Fort McKinley Cemetery as such. Therefore, this Feadquarters is not able to furnish 1044 case papers for CIL Number 323 (formerly X-3896-B, Manila, Mausoleum.)




