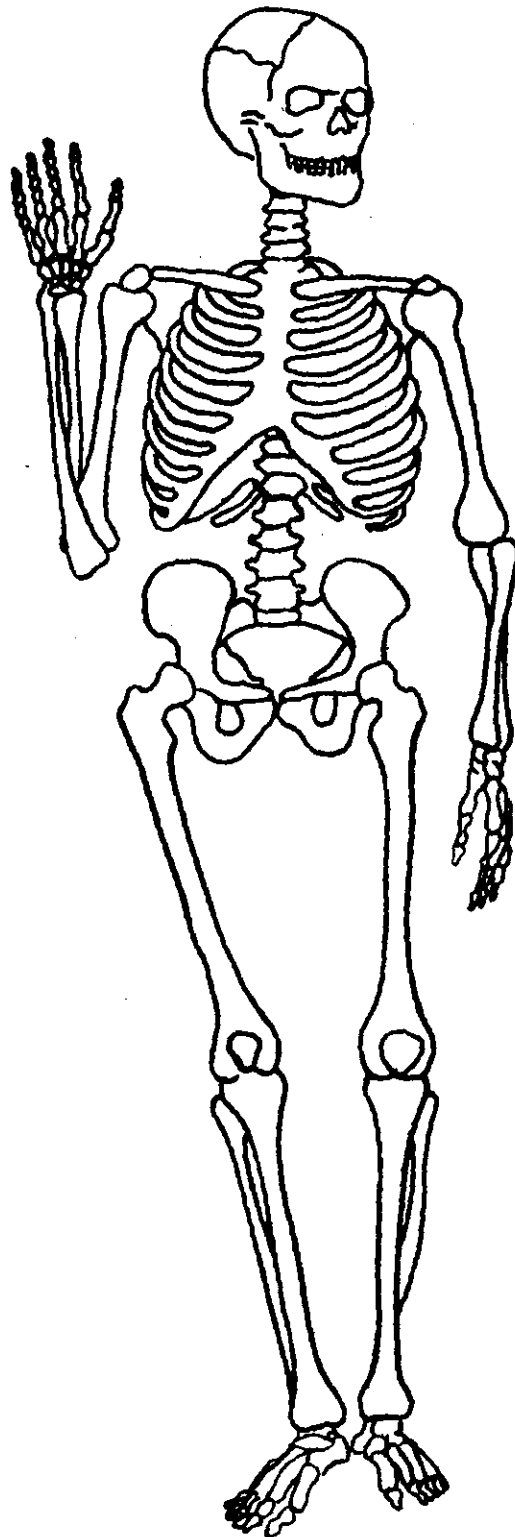

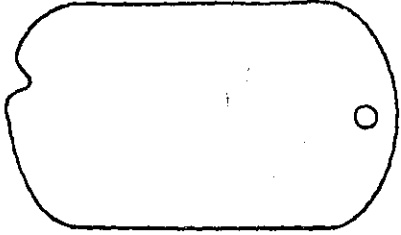



STATEMENT

I, Jose Macaspas, Filipino citizen of age and citizen of
Barrio Masbog, Hornon, Butuan, do declare:

That on February 28, 1942 during the Japanese bombing, I
saw four American soldiers about five hundred yards north from
this barrio, Masbog, Hornon, Butuan.

That I buried them two days later and mark the graves with
a cross.

That on June 4, 1947, I showed the graves to an American
Recovery Team.

That these are the remains of one of the unknown American
soldier,
