

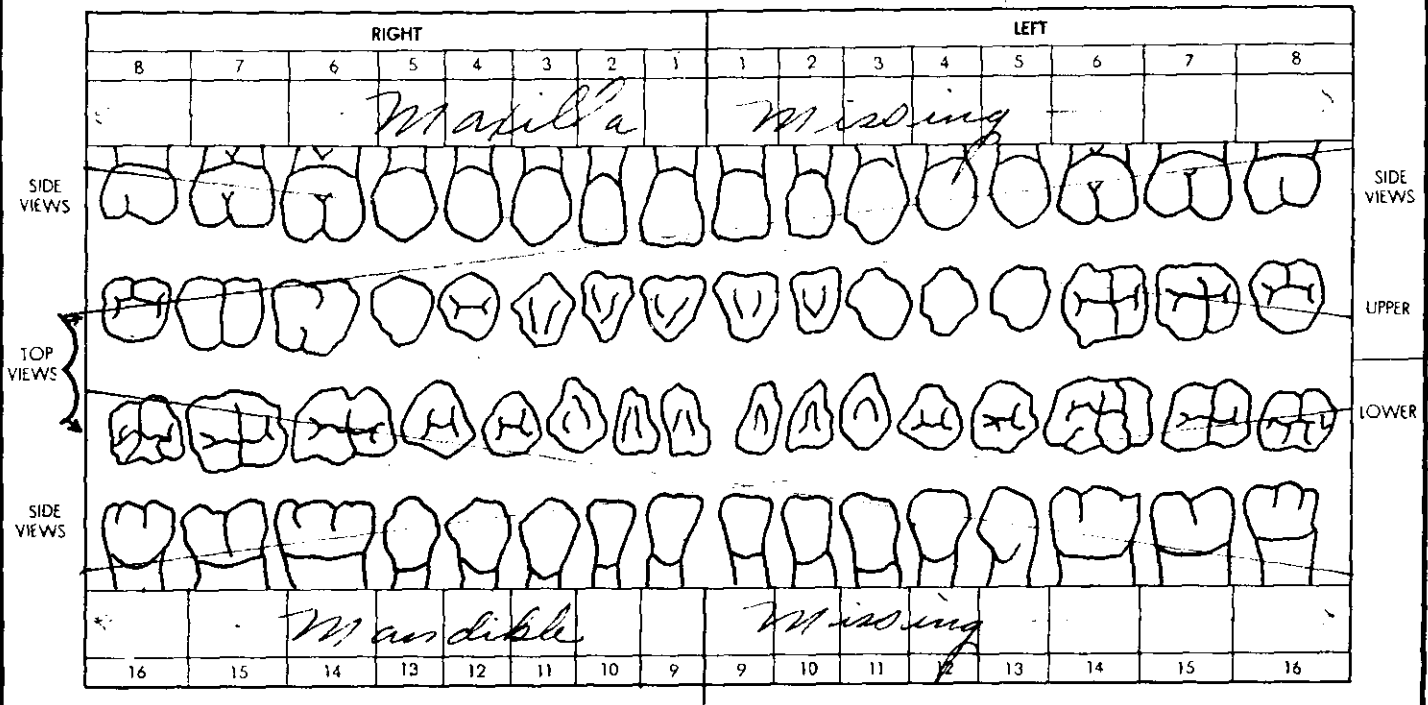

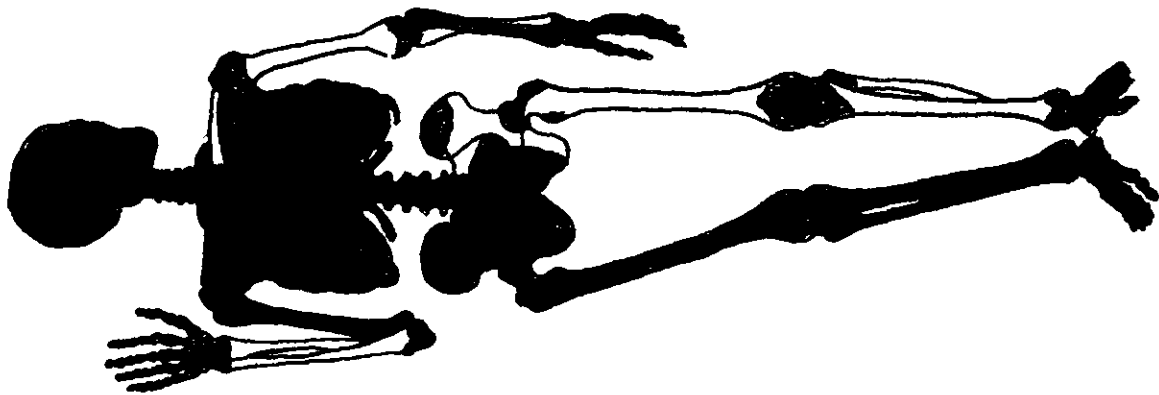

21. REMARKS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

While processing former X-1423, USAF Cem Manila #2, Luzon, P.I., extra bones were found, segregated into UNK X-3499-A, X-3499-B, X-3499-C, and X-3499-D.

Upon processing X-3499-C, no ROI bottle, I.D. tags, personal effects, or other means of identification received with remains. Estimated weight 1½ lbs. No skull nor teeth found. Unable to determine the physical height due to the absence of major bones. This UNK X-3499-C AGRS Mausoleum, Manila, P.I., possibly be one of the ten (10) names mentioned in previous ROI.

This remains is one of a group disinterred from Grave 901, Row 0, Plot 9 of Cabanatuan POW Cem Luzon, P.I. (Refer to UNK X-3499-A, X-3499-B, and X-3499-D).

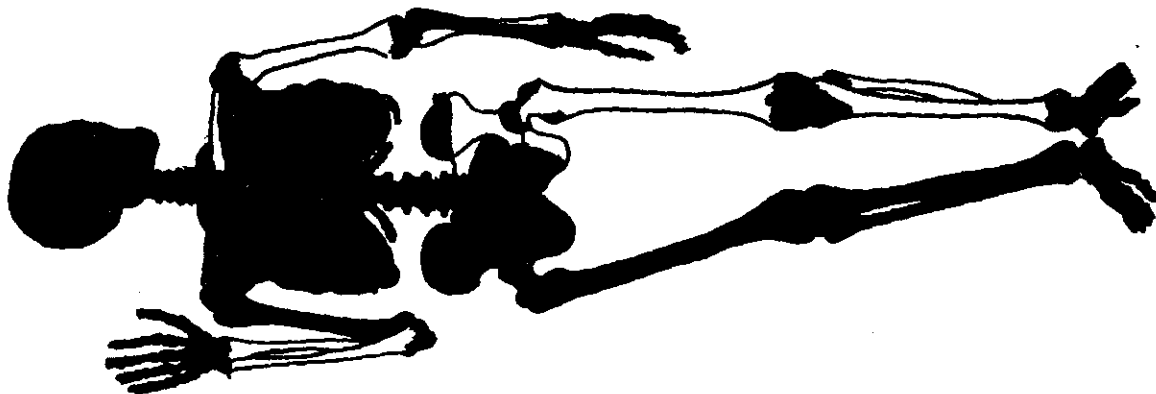
