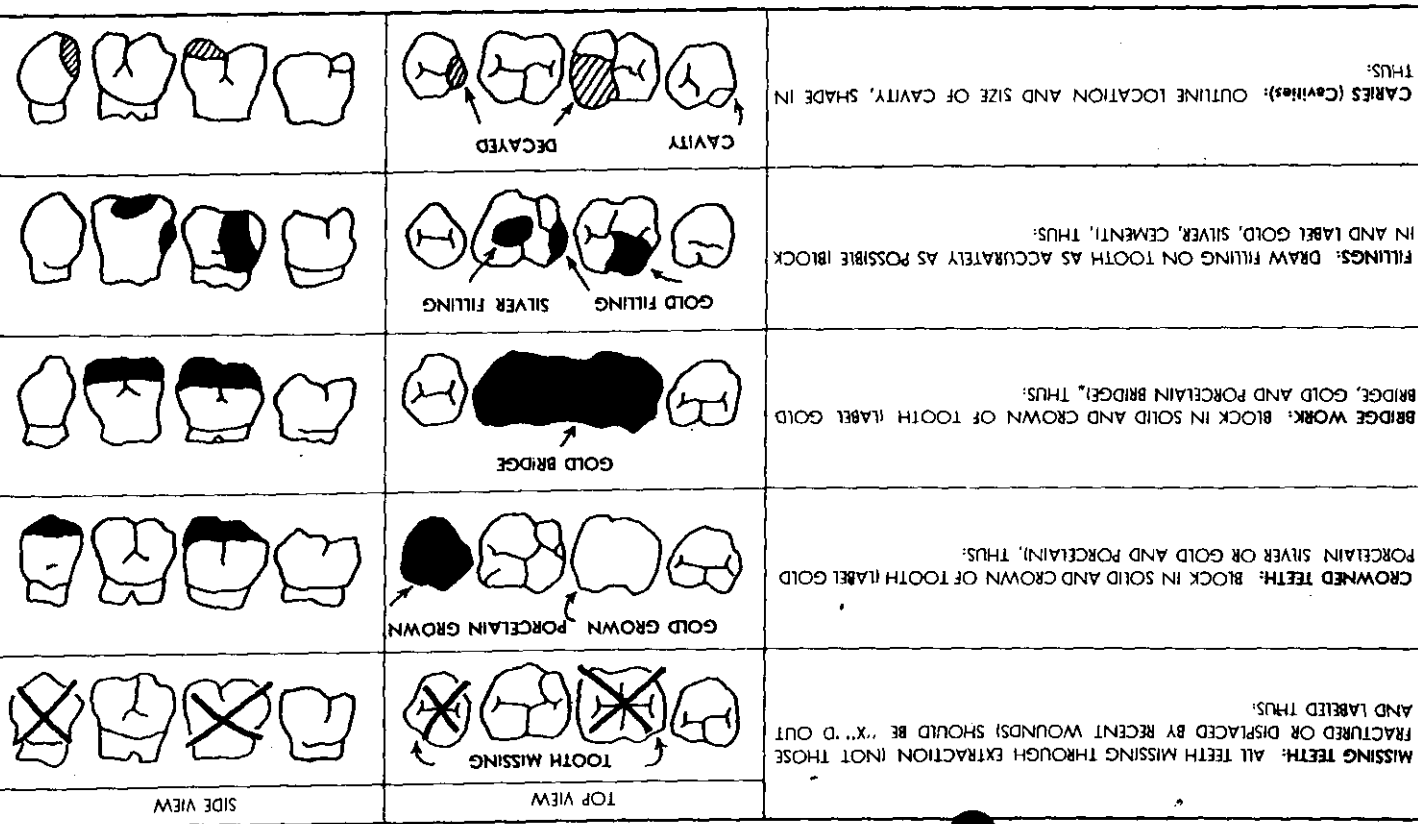
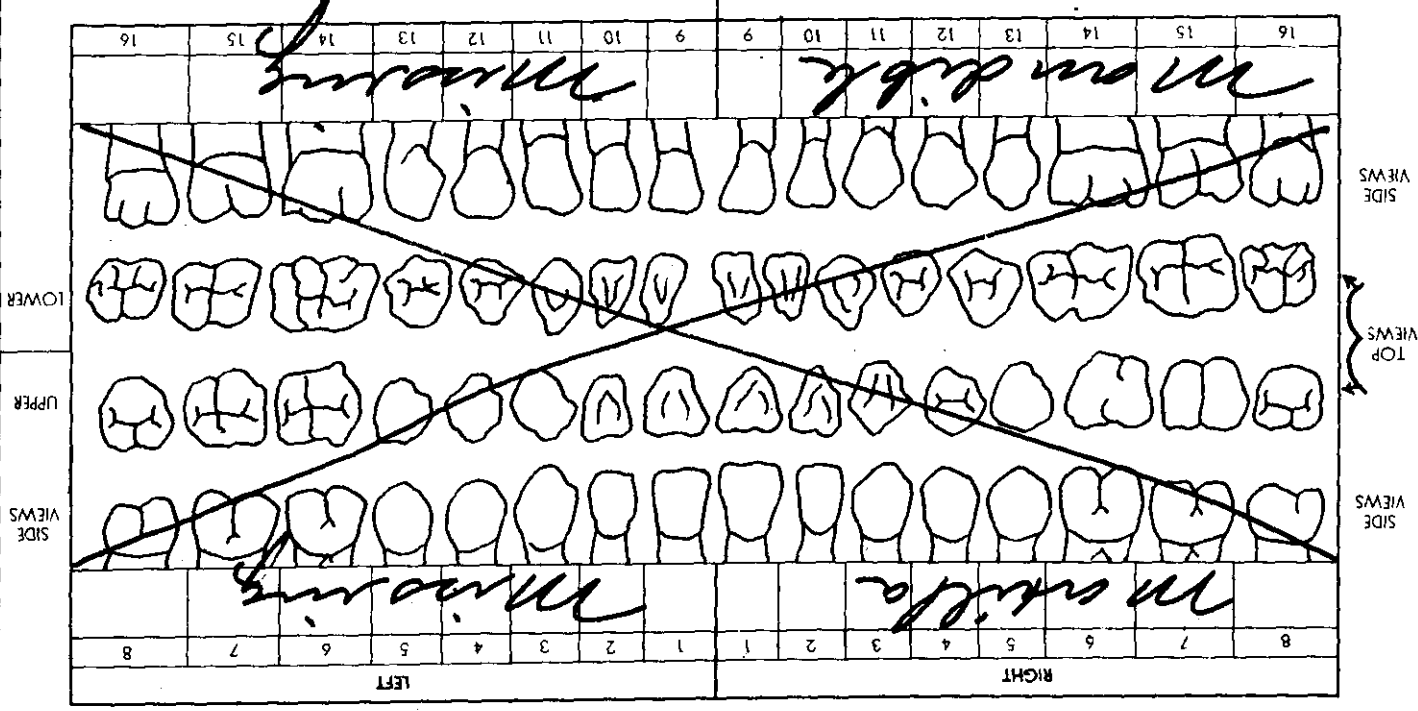

In processing the remains of UNK X-1442 USAF Cemetery Manila #2, Luzon, P.I., extra bones were found therefore they were segregated and designated as X-7520-A & B AGRS Mausoleum Manila, P.I. 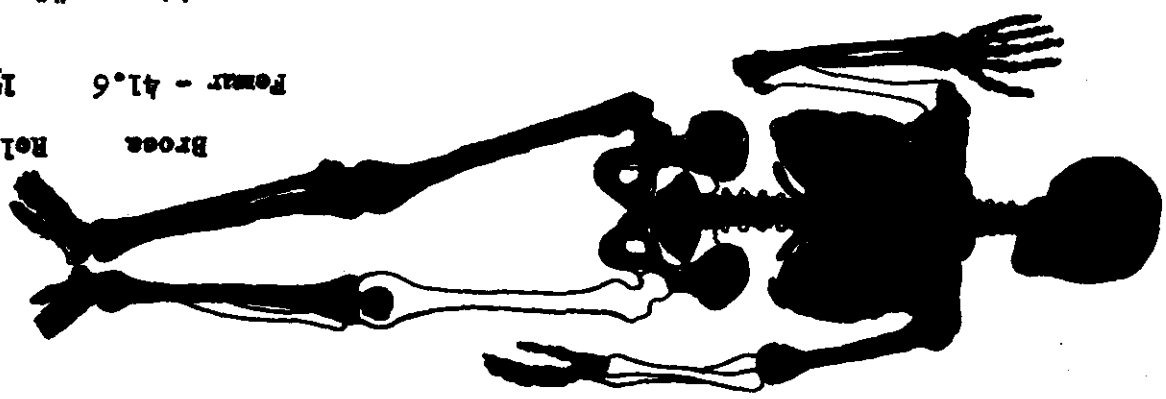
