*2 bone fragments*



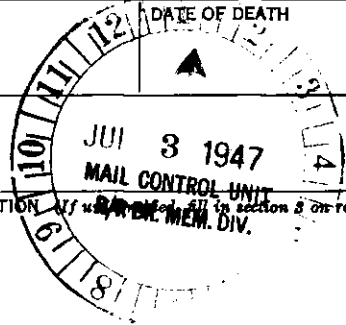
